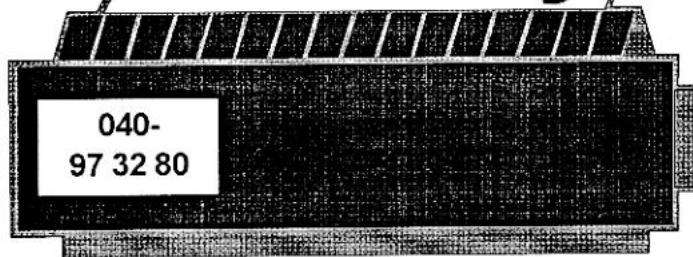

**Subj:** Radio Slovenija

*The following is copied from a letter I received from RADIO SLOVENIJA on 17 June 1993. My comments are between ().*

## **Programmes in English by Radio Slovenija**

1. From May 3 1st till September 1 1th Radio Slovenija is broadcasting every day except sundays and holidays from 9.35 till 10.00 a.m. (0735-0800 UTC) on I.

programme the programme "Tourist news for visitors from abroad" - in English, German and Italian - weather and road information, news, tourist information about Slovenia, emergency calls

2. From May 3 1st till September 1 1th Radio Slovenija is broadcasting "Holiday weather report" at 6.35 on I. and II. programme with special weather broadcast for Slovene mountains and the northern Adriatic (They do not specify a.m. or p.m., that is 0435 or 1635 UTC. However Guido Schotmans mentioned 0435 UTC a few days ago. Here in Brussels, the station fades out around 0615 UTC.)

3. From July 10th till August 28th Radio Slovenija is broadcasting from Friday 2.30 p.m. (1230 UTC) till Sunday 7.20 p.m. (1720 UTC) every hour the latest traffic report over the RDS and ARI system. - in English, German and Italian language.

From June 15th Radio Slovenija is broadcasting NEWS at 10.30 p.m. (2030 UTC) the whole year on the I. programme - in English and German language - news from Slovenia and international news

## **Frequencies**

I. programme: medium wave: 326,8 m = 918 kHz UKW (FM) 88,5 90,0 90,9 91,8 92,0 92,9 94,1 96,4 II. programme: UKW (FM) 87,8 92,4 93,5 94,1 95,3 96,9 97,6 98,9 99,9

(So: the NEWS at 2030 UTC is a new and permanent international service, which will be heard in large parts of Europe on 918 kHz after sunset; remember that a few years ago when Slovenia was still part of Yugoslavia a similar news service in English and German was broadcast around 10.15 pm, 2015 UTC) (I think listeners anywhere in Europe should encourage this new service) (Reports can be sent to Mrs Katarina FISTROVIC (with a V on the "C"), Secretary of Chief Engineer, Radio Slovenija, postnl predal 264/V, 61001 Ljubljana, Slovenia; FAX +38 61 317 066)

**Subj:** VOA's New Morocco Relay

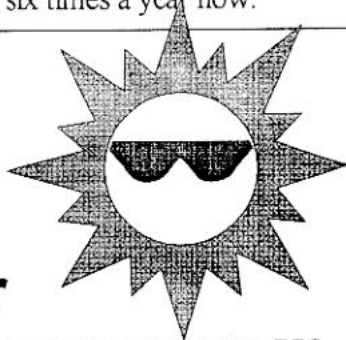
VOA's new Morocco relay station is expected to begin limited operation June 23, 1993. Two transmitters will be scheduled at 1600-2200 GMT. One will operate on 15410 kHz with English to Africa programming. The other will operate on 17785 kHz, with English at 1600-1730, Portuguese 1730-1830, and French to 2200 (except Mon-Fri 2030-2100 Hausa).

They got their budget for the news fiscal year (starting 1. July), but no increase over the last three years. With all the inflation this means they will have to reduce costs. HIGHLIGHTS OF SOLAR AND GEOMAGNETIC ACTIVITY 14 - 20 JUNE 1993

SOLAR ACTIVITY WAS VERY LOW UNTIL 19 JUNE WHEN THREE C-CLASS FLARES WERE OBSERVED. THESE FLARES ORIGINATED IN REGION 7524 (N-10, L-118, CLASS/AREA, AXX/010 ON 19 JUNE). THE LARGEST FLARE OF THE WEEK

WAS A C5/1N FLARE AT 19/2346UT. THERE WERE NO SIGNIFICANT PROTON ENHANCEMENTS OBSERVED AT SATELLITE ALTITUDES.

THE GEOMAGNETIC FIELD WAS MOSTLY QUIET. A KP INDEX OF 5 WAS OBSERVED AT 14/0900-1200UT. THIS SUBSTORM ENDED ABRUPTLY AND THE REST OF THE WEEK WAS QUIET.

## **Forecast of Solar and Geomagnetic Activity 23 June-19 July**

SOLAR ACTIVITY IS EXPECTED TO INCREASE TO LOW, WITH A CHANCE FOR ISOLATED M-CLASS FLARE ACTIVITY. OLD REGION 7518 (S10, L-015) WHICH WAS GROWING AS IT EXITED THE DISK, IS DUE BACK ON 24 JUNE. THIS REGION MAY HAVE BEEN THE SOURCE OF THE LONG DURATION FLARE OF 20 JUNE.

THE GEOMAGNETIC FIELD IS EXPECTED TO BE MOSTLY UNSETTLED. CORONAL HOLES ARE EXPECTED TO INCREASE ACTIVITY ON 23-24 JUNE AND 01-02 JULY.
