OFFICIAL WWCR PRESS RELEASE 28 April 1995

We have found it necessary to, at least temporarily, suspend the airing of the program "The Intelligence Report." The adverse publicity against programs of this nature in the aftermath of the Oklahoma City bombing and indiscriminate killing of innocent people including children, has caused us to reconsider our responsibility as a broadcaster. We do believe in the Bill of Rights and the First Amendment of the US Constitution, including the freedom of speech. To paraphrase the words of a very famous American, "Although I may not believe in what you say, I will defend with my life your right to say it." We find ourselves today in a violent world, with the breakdown of families and family values, with parents and children killing each other, ethnic cleansing killings in Bosnia and elsewhere, terrorist attacks all over the world, excessive violence permeating our movies and television, and the concentration of our news media (cable, t.v., radio, newspapers, etc.), to focus on this violence, in part generated by a public ever thirsty for grisly tales of horror. Somewhere and somehow it must be stopped! We must all contribute to that effort. It is as wrong to accuse any one group (no matter how "far-right" it may be), of responsibility for the irrational, irresponsible and criminal actions of the Oklahoma City incident, as it is to accuse, for example, the anti-abortion movement of responsibility when one of its believers deliberately kills a doctor who may be performing abortions. But those who use the media, radio, newspaper, television, short-wave, etc., need to understand that their words, to paraphrase a recent editorial, "no matter how innocent or rhetorical or satirical they may in fact be, have the power to push certain people over the edge, into violence." We don't mean to suggest that such broadcasters should be shut-up, only to remind them that it is possible to be both conservative and responsible. It is not enough for such broadcasters to satisfy themselves that they meant no harm. They need to reflect on the possibility that their excessive language can lead other people over whom they have no direct control, to do harm, and that their bitter words can have consequences. Due to the volume of our programs we at WWCR are not able to review programs in advance or even during their airing for content. We do rely upon our listeners to alert us when they hear offensive material and whe they do, we review the program and closely monitor it in the future. **H2340** *R Central*, Riobamba, Ecuador, is regular at 1030.

**H2480.6** *R Sonorama*, Riobamba, Ecuador, is also quite regular 1000-1100 with mainstream LA music. ID on top of the hour only.

**3194.6** Back on the air, on a slightly readjusted frequency, *R Jerusalén*, at "Atahualpa-Jerusalén", Peru. First noticed on April 6, at 1010 with "La Biblia dice". Programmes consist of gospel programmes (transcription services) and locally produced gospel music with TC's. ID's are scarce. This station has been off the air since last year. The DJ is also a new one.

**3201-3205v** Here's the present venue of the Colombian *La Voz de la Colina*, at Risaralda (Caldas). During most of March, the station was on frequencies varying between **3167** and **3187**. The signal does appear to be stronger than a harmonic would be, and, as a matter of fact, they have been announcing both 1600 and 3200 kHz on the air. Music messages cost \$150 only, and that's a ridiculous sum. I can't understand how they can make ends meet.

**3255** New frequency for *R dif 6 de Agosto*, Xapuri, Acre, Brazil, listed in the WRTH on 3401 kHz. Having noticed the frequency several days earlier, I identified the stn only on April 3, at 1030. Transmissions are said to be *em carácter experimental*.

**3579.7** *R Católica Nacional*, San Carlos (Túquerres), Colombia, unheard since early February, back on the air early April, i.e. on the 6th, at 0110 w/HC music.

**H4231.1** *Caracol Vélez*, Colombia, heard almost nightly around 2300. This indicates a fundamental of **1410.35** kHz.

**4613v** New frequency for *R Soledad*, Peru, in early April, replacing **4632v**. (On March 27, on **4630.7**, then silent for several days). The signal is definitely weaker now than it used to be. On April 6, s/on with NA at 1020. The freq was given as 4648 kHz in the 62 metre band.

**4884.8** *Ondas del Meta*, Colombia, on a slightly adjusted frequency, since March 18.

**H4902** A terrific spur from Brazilian *R Progreso*, Porto Velho, listed on 4945, first identified April 4. Is audible morning and night.

**4915.3** *Armonías del Caquetá*, Colombia, is active on this frequency daytime only. Pulling the plug shortly before midnight UTC.

**4945.1** *R Illimani*, "La Voz de Bolivia", back on a regular basis from March 27. Good signal.

**4953** Peruvian *R Madre de Dios* on this frequency since medio March. Samtidigt blev det så tyst, så tyst på 4950...

**5017** Peruvian *Estación Tarapoto* with a strong signal on this frequency, March 25, 1122, in the course of their "Notidario La Mañana en la noticia". A few days later, back on **5014.8**.

**5046.3** A new Peruvian, first reported by TIN, in his "Relámpago DX", *R Integración*, at Abancay, in the *departamento* of Apurímac, also announcing as *Inti R*, 1520 kHz, has been regular here since medio March. Sign on varies between 1025 and 1055. First programme of the day features Peruvian "folklore". Announcements are in Quechua and Spanish. Lots of electoral ads prior to nationwide elections April 9. Other regular ads include those of Universidad Tecnológica de los Andes and *panadería* San Carlos. There is a news programme at 1130. On April 7, at 1042, they played the entire carted *sign off* announcement just like that... This station has not been heard at night.

**5049.6** Peruvian *R Tayacaja*, at Pampas, signing on regularly at 1105, co-channelled by spur from *La Voz del Cinaruco*, whose fundamental is 4865.1. [*La V del Cinaruco* is on extended sked nowadays, on March 18 even at night, relaying *R Reloj*, Bogotá, 1100 kHz, with confusing anncts for "Caracol Colombia y Caracol Miami", which, of course, is WSUA 1260 kHz]. The Peruvian is presently also heard at night.

**5116.4** *R Diez*, Peru, is normally silent. For some reason or other, they were active on March 14, at 0030, in the course of the evening newcast "Yo soy la voz del pueblo".

**5123.7** *R Galaxia*, Bolivia, noticed active again, April 1, 0030, with gospel prgr.

**5453.9** Ecuadorian pirate *R Alianza* was last heard March 18, 2130.

**5547.4** *R La Voz de Andamachay*, Peru, is regular here after midnight and until 0200 s/off. Announcements say "transmitiendo para todo el Perú, América y el mundo", so they seem to be aware that the signal is propagating far afield.

**5894.8** *R Paucartambo*, Peru, provides a crisp signal in the morning before 1100 when they are offering folklore galore, as well as interesting ads for "El Charapita", who is buying second-hand bicycles at first-rate value. This station is much more difficult to catch at night. Their s/off still appears to be at midnight.

**5974.3** *R Macarena*, Colombia, has been on this frequency since the end of February.

**6115.8** *La Voz del Llano*, Colombia, on this adjusted freq since early March.

**6195.9** This is the new, slightly adjusted freq of *R Metropolitana "la radio popular"*, Bolivia, April 8, 2341.

**6299.2** *Sani R*, Honduras, provides a booming signal every night from s/on 0100. Music requests accepted to phone number 987516. (There is no area code for Puerto Lempira).

**6281.7** During the past few years, and similar to the Cuban practice, the Peruvian government has coined a slogan for each year. *R Huancabamba*, on March 14, at s/on 1105, revealed this year's slogan: "año de inversiones productivas" (year of profitable investments). Last year slogan was "año de modernización educativa y del deporte", and those of 1993 and 1992 were, respectively, "año de la modernización educativa" (sic) and "año de César Vallejo y el encuentro de dos mundos".

**6237.9** *Estación Yurimaguas*, Peru, is definitely back on a regular basis as from April 1 at least. Freq is .1 kHz lower than before.

**6544.6** *R Imperial*, Calle de Ayabaca 339-341, Huancabamba, is a new one on this frequency, which used to be the whereabouts of *R Centinela "La Voz de las Guaringas"*, in the same town. First noticed March 16, just before midnight, thanks to alert on HCJB TLC. Uses slogan "La Voz de la Peruanidad". A regular programme is "Paraíso musical", between midnight and 0100. S/off is at 0200. S/on is given as 7 a.m., local time.
