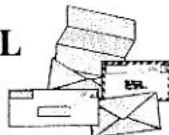

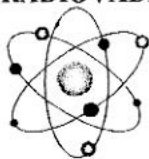

SPACE WEATHER OUTLOOK SEPTEMBER 18-20 FROM SPACE ENVIRONMENT LABORATORY

SOLAR ACTIVITY IS EXPECTED TO BE LOW FOR THE NEXT THREE DAYS. A SLIGHT CHANCE OF M-CLASS ACTIVITY IS STILL POSSIBLE FROM REGION 7912. THE GEOMAGNETIC FIELD IS EXPECTED TO BE MOSTLY QUIET TO UNSETTLED FOR DAY ONE OF THE FORECAST PERIOD. BY DAY TWO, THE FIELD IS EXPECTED TO BE MOSTLY UNSETTLED TO ACTIVE IN RESPONSE TO THE M4/1F TYPE II SWEEP OF 13 OCT. THESE CONDITIONS ARE EXPECTED TO PERSIST THROUGH DAY THREE.

FORECAST OF SOLAR AND GEOMAGNETIC ACTIVITY 11 OCTOBER 1995 - 06 NOVEMBER 1995

SOLAR ACTIVITY IS EXPECTED TO BE VERY LOW TO LOW THROUGH 19 OCTOBER. VERY LOW LEVELS ARE EXPECTED FOR THE BALANCE OF THE PERIOD. NO SIGNIFICANT PROTON ENHANCEMENTS ARE EXPECTED. THE GREATER THAN 2 MEV ELECTRON FLUX IS EXPECTED TO BE AT MODERATE TO HIGH LEVELS THROUGH 13 OCTOBER. MOSTLY NORMAL LEVELS ARE EXPECTED 14 - 30 OCTOBER. HIGH LEVELS ARE EXPECTED TO OCCUR FROM 31 OCTOBER - 06 NOVEMBER.

THE GEOMAGNETIC FIELD IS EXPECTED TO BE MOSTLY UNSETTLED THROUGH 29 OCTOBER, ALTHOUGH ACTIVE PERIODS ARE POSSIBLE DURING 24 - 25 OCTOBER. RECURRENT CORONAL HOLE EFFECTS ARE EXPECTED TO COMMENCE ON 30 OCTOBER AND PERSIST THROUGH THE END OF THE PERIOD. ACTIVE TO MAJOR STORM CONDITIONS ARE EXPECTED DURING THIS TIME. BRIEF SEVERE STORM CONDITIONS ARE ALSO POSSIBLE, ESPECIALLY AT HIGHER LATITUDES.

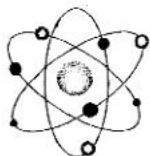

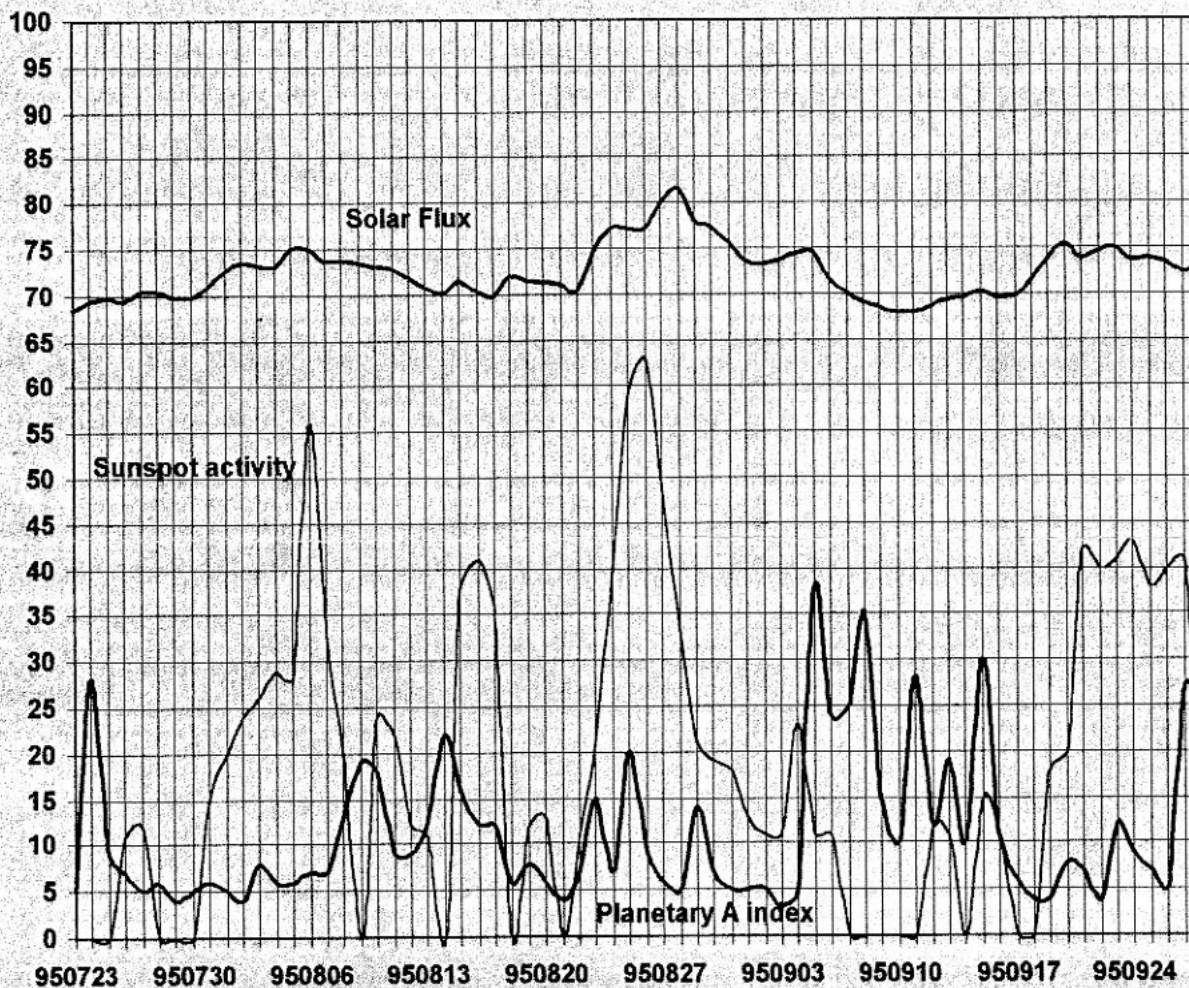

Solar terrestrial activity report



Development during the last few days: The geomagnetic field was mostly quiet until the 27th when an unexpected transient caused minor storm levels for the latter half of the day and the first half of the 28th. The disturbance is now thought to have been caused by an undetected coronal mass ejection. There is only one visible sunspot group.

Forecast for the next few days: The geomagnetic field is expected to become quiet until October 2 when a coronal hole related disturbance should arrive. As of Sept. 28 the coronal hole was visible and about 4 days away from being geoeffective.

Info on solar cycle 23: The first group belonging to the new cycle was observed on August 12. Up until Sept.28 only 2 other groups belonging to the new cycle has been observed.
