BRAZIL 4765 "ZYI534, onda media 710 kHz, ZYG263, ondastropicais 4765 kHz, R Emissora de Educacao Rural Santarem Ltda., Santarem, Para. Uma emissora da Diocese de Santarem". That's their top of the hour id as heard May 17, 1100, prior to the station's "Jornal da Manha".

5092.9 Unid heard several evenings around 2300; does not seem to announce at regular intervals as Brazilians do, but does carry "A Voz do Brasil". Harmonic or spur?

CLANDESTINE (Colombia) 6250 R Patria Libre anned sked 1 pm and 5 pm, the latter segment is on the air almost daily now. In addition to their usual prgr now also running political "PSA's". Very good signal.

COLOMBIA H2460.4 R Viva, Pasto, fundamental anned 1230, good during local darkness. Carries lots of local adverts and some Sistema Super hook ups (Bogota 970 kHz), but even in the course of their local prgr they use the slogan "La Superestación". May 18 football, ending 0150, was also carried by Emisora Cultural Bolivar, Ipiales. Local canned ID (jingle & spoken), "1230 en su dial, R Viva, viva Nariño. Con R Viva, musica y noticias para una radio mas viva". Mentions phone as 219366 and 219368. (I am not going to give them any call.)

H3126.3 La V de Pradera, Pradera, Valle, May 18, 2315 with prgr "Destapando colas", anncing 1600 kHz. S/off 2359 with NA. Poor signal and distorted audio.

6063.8 Colmundo Bogota, noted with their new 5 kW tx May 17, 2155.

ECUADOR 3568.7 R Luciernaga del Condor, Yanzatza, Zamora Chinchipe, nightly from before 2300; sign off May 18 was at 0230 (without NA or annct, just petering out after a pasillo).

PERU 6173.8 R Tawantinsuyo unexpectedly in the clear May 18, 0005 with "La hora estelar de los incas del Peru", sponsored by local truck dealer Diesel Andina, followed by an esoteric show, "Cosas de la vida". ID, "R Tawantinsuyo, primera en el corazón del pueblo, por sus cuatro frecuencias, onda media, tropical, corta y FM 94.6".

6261 R. JVL, also identifying itself as "Frecuencia Musical (and: Frecuencia Nacional) de los 62-60". Frequent adverts for Electronica El Futuro, Av. Tupac Amaru 105, run by someone by the name of León Villanueva, which makes me wonder if this fellow has something to do with the station. On May 20, a young basketball player by the name of Ester was invited say hello on the air. As a student at the local Colegio Juan Velazco Alvarado (Peruvian military dictator from the 70's) she greeted "la audiencia de R. JVA", which, if a 'Freudian slip', would indicate that station name is JVL rather than JBL.

6997.6 R San Ignacio, Av. Santa Rosa 751, San Ignacio (Jaen). has been off the air for the last few days. Station is run by Cesar Colunche, who used to run R Huancabamba, 6281v, silent for the time being but to hit the air again soon, per Colunche, May 11, when he was entertaining studio guests such as Lucho Julca, owner of Estereo 100, and Oscar Vasquez Chacon, ex-DJ on R Frecuencia San Ignacio, 5700, and now mgr (not the owner) of R Peru, 7032. Colunche said he'd take phone calls at (0)94 716238 plus two other numbers. I gave it a try, but at the other end was a chap by the name of Evaristo Campos, who wasn't even at the station but at his own car repair business at Av. Santa Rosa 701. Colunche got the message, however, and in discussing habits of "radioaficionados" on the air, he remembered his "gran amigo Takayuki" who went to see him at R Huancabamba. - This R San Ignacio operation seems to be totally different from the one which was on 6751 in June 1995, on 6747.2 from Aug 1995 to July 1996, when they moved to 6746.2 and, in Sept, to 6753.3 which was to be their last recorded frequency.

NU 1424, May 11, 1997

ARGENTINA. 8098, LSB feeder relaying LS4, R. Continental, B.A. (590 MW), 0302 May 8, ending newscast: "Hasta aqui el Panorama Informativo de la Medianoche . . . servicio informativo Continental," followed by Alejandro Dolina's "La Venganza Sera Terrible" at 0305. Very weak. (Nigro-Uruguay)

CHILE. 5824.90, R. Triunfal Evangelica, 2233-2304 May 2, a lot of gospel mx, then praises by the Bishop and Director of the stn, Fernando Gonzalez Segura, nonstop gospel mx. On May 3 hrd the s/on at 2200 with ID as "Esta es R. Triunfal Evangelica . . ." On this day hrd on 5824.94. (GIB/CV-Argentina)

LA HARMONICS. 3180.7(H) (decimal estimated), the one formerly reported by myself as CD159, R. Llanquihue, Llanquihue, Chile is hrd here, 0155 May 9, but IDing as CD159, Em. Tepual (maybe "Cepual"), and located at Puerto Montt. It uses the slogan, "La Popular." Ending "Mexico y sus Canciones" prgm: "En El Tepual, La Popular, hemos presentado Mexico y sus Canciones." Ad for "Empresas Funerarias Puerto Montt" offering "Capillas ardientes facilitadas sin motorcito de luz" (the lighted room where a dead body lies in state and supplied without those portable, and noisy, electricity generators). Promo for esoteric prgm to be b/c on Sunday at 2200 local time: "Una cita con su . . . a partir de este domingo a las 22 horas en Emisora(s?) Tepual." ID: "En su sintonia, CD159, Em. Tepual, en amplitud modulada, desde Puerto Montt." QSB, sigs rising up and down, 0-1 to 5! Condx improved enough to get this one IDed better. (Nigro-Uruguay)

The NB7030: "I have received one of the first review samples of one of the new AOR AR7030 accessories, the NB7030 notch and filter board and enhanced processor. . . The board and new processors took me about an hour and a half to fit. It was quite a fussy job--not recommended for ex-blacksmiths or people who are not used to fine soldering. (But I also had to relocate my crystal filter daughter board.) It all seems to work. It has been on for half an hour as I write. Very first impressions: (1) The notch filter is great, as good as the Datong FL3. The auto and manual functions work well. It is good enough to get rid of a carrier whistle when you offtune in ECSS. (2) The noise filter--I have yet to find one that works on a rx. It has an adjustable level control and bandwidth, but conditions are not such that I can really test it yet. (3) The textual identifier seems to be a lot of fun, and also intelligent enough to be useful. The memory search seems to look for the fqy stored in all the memories, and if one is a close match for the one tuned, it will display the appropriate text ID for 10 seconds. Great for people like me with poor memories. (4) There is also a facility to copy and paste memory settings around the new improved capacity of 400 memories. Scanning seems to take place in blocks of 100 memories. (5) The new menuing seems logical and intuitive to me. If you don't like modern black boxes with few knobs and lots of functions, think twice. It would seem that the UK AOR team have continued their innovative magic, and have given the SWL and serious DXer even more tools to make their catches. I wish they made cars." Don Phillips, DSWCI (Hard-Core-DX).

NU 1424, May 18, 1997

ARGENTINA. 8098U, R. del Plata FM, slightly moved from 8100. Noted poorly at 0700-0728 May 11, romantic vocals and light talk by YL. ID at 0722 as "95.1, La FM del Plata." The stn also IDed as "Estacion 95." Tnx to Shoji Yamada for this tip. (TIN-Japan)

8098L, R. Rivadavia, slightly moved from 8100, fair at 0728-0800 May 11, tango, man talking. At 0800, a nx flash was hrd. Also fair at 1005-1030 May 18, light talk and wx info. ID at 1030. (TIN-Japan)

CANADA. 1670, R. Asia Canada, license for this fqy sought by Canadian Asian B/Cing Corp. (CABC), an ethnic radio production company, mostly Tamil. Likely to get license, and may be active as early as July. Also pursuing satellite and SW relays. (Jeff Cohen-WRN via WoR)

4877.5, RCI, 2340 May 11, another 60-m. RCI subharmonic (along with 4812.5) showing very weakly here carrying an interview with woman reminiscing about her childhood. Fair on 9755 fundamental. (Hill-MA)
