Det er også her nesten ingen peruanere untatt Satelite som er kanonsterk og Ondas del Rio Mayo på 6797 ellers så er det bare de vanligste stasjonene som høres.

Mellombølgen har vært svært så interessant de siste ukene med Radio Corporación -1380 med QSA 3 i godt over en time uten en fade out. 1440 er også interessant med en engelsktalende stasjon som har Dr. Scott på programmet omkring kl 0230. På 1350 har jeg en Beograd på allround antennen, med flere LA på 340 mot vest som egentlig ble laget som en Beaver for 60 og 90 mb, har ingen effekt i disse båndene - gir derimot gode signaler mot LA i mellombølgen. Har også logget Nevis på 895.

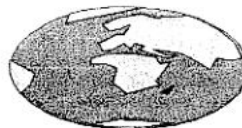

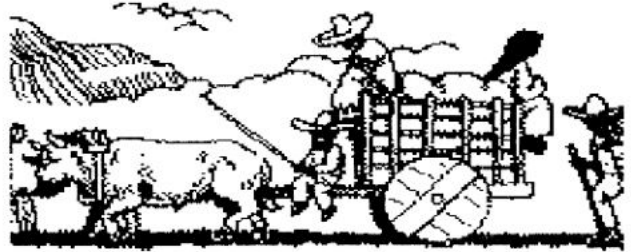
DATELINE BOGOTA

August 2, 1997

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Previous bulletin was edited June 19. No monitoring Jul 1 - Aug 1.

BOLIVIA

4864.4 "16 de Marzo", loud and clear, Jun 19, with "Mañana minera" prgr ending 1030, followed by TC and ID for 102 MHz and 4865 "kcs", then into "Recuento informativo" news prgr.

4991 "Animas la radio", Jun 19, 1042-1054, with magazine type prgr featuring stories quoted from the local newspaper and selections of music. Canned ID, 1050, and into prgr apparently called "Su hora de cooperativismo". R Ancash took over by 1055.

CLANDESTINE

6250 R Patria Libre, Jun 22, 2158-2216- with Venezuelan tecnopop music for a starter, followed by "La revista de la semana" and "Rompiendo las cadenas". Good signal. [Unheard when resuming monitoring early Aug]

6259.2 V de la Resistencia, Aug 2, 2158-2230, considerably weaker than R Patria Libre. Opening music followed by ID, 2207, "Transmite Voz de la Resistencia, Comando conjunto occidental. [music] Fuerzas Armadas Revolucionarias del Pueblo, Farc-EP". ID in conjunction with instrumental version of "Mi Buenaventura" as a cue, at 2211, 2215, 2221 and 2225, before, between and after three spoken political commentaries. ID at 2225 went "Transmitio Voz de la Resistencia [etc]. Los esperamos en una proxima emision. Gracias. Hasta pronto". Transmission ended by a 4-minute vocal version of "La Internacional". - This station has not been heard since Sept 1996.

COLOMBIA

4915.0 Armonias del Caqueta, Aug 2, 2308, ballads.

5019.3 Ecos del Atrato with local music prgr despite anno'ts such as "Bienvenidos a escuchar 'Los vallenatos de siempre' por Caracol", Aug 2, 2307.

6115.2 (new fq) "la internacional Voz del Llano", Aug 2, 2252, with merengues and other tropical music.

PERU

5522.2 R Sudamerica, Aug 2, 2355. Unheard for over a year.

5678.1 (new fq) R Frecuencia San Ignacio, Aug 2, 2331, s/on with NA and usual 'battle-hymn' "Mi frontera es mi frontera".

5767.1 (new station) R Master, is ex R Universal, ex-ex R Estelar and ex-ex-ex Estacion Soritor, Jun 26, 1151 with "Ecuador y sus grandes canciones". QTH announced as Jiron 20 de Abril 308. Poor-to-fair. [In "LA DXing No. 6", edited by Radio Nuevo Mundo, there are some highly interesting pictures related to the predecessors of R Master. They were taken by Takayuki Inoue in Jan 1997].

5789.8 (new fq) "Ilucan la radio", Aug 2, 2256-2327 when transmission was interrupted, probably due to some transmitter failure.

6250.7 R La Voz, Jun 28, 1131, spoken ad saying, "Visitenos en el Jiron Cesar Vallejo, Comercial Kelly". - On 6250.2, Aug 2, 2355.

6676.1 R Huamachuco, Jun 28, 2310, plugging for "Conferencia de los Adventistas del 7o. dia, del 3 al 6 de julio, en Huamachuco". - Unheard, Aug 2, 2330.

7040.4 R San Ignacio, Jun 26, 1300-1400 with "Latin Show" run by owncr's son, Fredy Colunche. Played Tito Rojas' tune "Esperandote con los brazos abiertos" for yours truly.

7141.7 (new fq) R Ayabaca, Aug 2, 2148, talk show run by "maestro curandero", prgr of HC music started on top of the hours. Weak.

ARGENTINA. 6059.93, R. Nacional, fair at 0900-0906 Jul 21, oracion matinal, then into nx flash. (TIN-Japan)
8098U, LS11 presumed, noted in passing at 0330 Jul 20, Argentine SP ads ment. La Plata and Buenos Aires, fair-good level. (Crawford-FL)

A La Plata MW stn (1270) b/cs on Sundays (local day) on SW fqys a SP prgm called "De Coleccion", Sunday at *2300 to Monday at 0200. This prgm is beamed to Antarctica in SSB mode. The stn uses only one or two of the following fqys: 3390, 4469, 5400, 5415 or 8098. When there is a soccer xmsn, "De Coleccion" starts with some time delay. (This info is supplied by Raymundo Cruz from La Plata city, and, according to Jorge Aloy, the stn is also on 13361 or 13365.) Mr. Jorge Bourdet, editor of the prgm, says that at 0115-0130 they have a phone contact with listeners directly to the air in a segment called "charla con los oyentes, la distancia tiene premio" (talking with the listeners, the distance have award) at phone number 54-21-270507 or 54-21-216607, where the award is a cassette recorded with this same conversation that is sent to the listener. The prgm will confirm all rcprn rpts about this SW xmsn with a very nice LS11 QSL with full details (date, time, fqy). Send your rpts to: "De Coleccion," Sr. Jorge Bourdet, Casilla 96, 1900-La Plata, Argentina, and please include 2 IRCs. Mr. Bourdet also is in charge of the prgm, "Con cierto estilo" (with certain style), b/c Mon-Fri at 2200-0000 on the same stn. (GIB-Argentina) I recall earlier info on this from a long time ago. (JB)

BOLIVIA. 6105.37, R. Panamericana, 1038-1050 Jul 23, M&W alternating with nx items, "mas informacion de Radio . . ." nx regarding "el presidente de Ecuador" and a conference in Ecuador; good signal using narrow filter, AM mode. (Wilkner-FL) 6105, 0058 Jul 26, stn promo about the addition of its FM outlet: "A la calidad de sus emisiones en AM y en onda corta, Panamericana agrega la calidad FM en 106.3 . . ." Ad for "Discolandia." (Nigro-Uruguay)
6194.69, R. Carlos Palenque, fair at *0901-0930 Jul 20, s/on with CP folklore and opening anmt. (TIN-Japan)
SIM (formerly "Sudan Interior Mission," ELWA's parent), along with some other missions and organizations, is building a Quechua-lang. stn in Cochabamba, to be SW at first, maybe local FM later. Stn name sounded like (phonetically) Radio Montochaski ("New Messenger" in Quechua). They have done many studies and much planning already, and license request is presently pending with the govt. Will be a state-of-the-art facility, with studios in town, xmtr 13-14 km away, line-of-sight; "H" antenna, 6 m. off the ground, signal to be beamed straight up rather than going for distance [a la Australian NWT svc. and R. El Buen Pastor--JB]. However, they expect to reach northern Argentina and parts of Chile and Peru, as well as Bolivia. They are already building the studio, and the property for the xmtr site is purchased and they are building there as well. Said power would be 10 watts [but interviewee was non-technical and, hopefully, meant 10 kw--JB]. Xmtr is about to be purchased in PA for about \$75,000, but they are awaiting final word from the Bolivian govt. re licensure. Application has been accepted, but law was recently changed. They expect to be on the air within the first 6 mos. of 1998 if the license comes through shortly. "The next few weeks will be critical in obtaining appropriate signatures from the govt." (Interview of Paul Erickson, SIM, over HCJB DXPL)

TONGA. Per telecon with Mgalu Susimalohi, Deputy General Mgr of R. Tonga, they returned to SW in early June with "all-night b/cs" on 5030, but almost immediately Cyclone Hina struck Tonga and Fiji in mid-June and took out TBC's antennas and satellite link. The latter is provided under contract and can only be repaired by the BBC technicians in Australia. TBC is anxious to return to SW, but is at the mercy of the BBC's availability. (Hankison in Cumbre, via EDXP)

URUGUAY. From NU 1434, Supp. B, Aug 1: 9621, CXA6, SODRE, Montevideo has been reactivated, hrd at 0237-0300* Jul 29, nominal 9620. Simulcasting CX26 (1050 MW). Uruguayan contemporary mx to closing anmt (canned, not ment. SW), NA, s/off at 0255. Carrier went up to 0300. Het due to REE's SP prgm to LA on 9620 at this hour, "which results completely blocked over here." Latest info available from Uruguayan Telecom ("Direccion Nacional de Comunicaciones, Division Tecnica, Departamento de Radiodifusion") regarding SW outlets assigned, and IFRB registered to Uruguay, dated Oct 26, 1995, shows that this channel is registered as follows: CXA61, assigned to have a maximum output of 20 kw; 320 degrees, 0200-0400; 38 degrees, 1000-2200 and 2200-0200. This is purely theoretical, however, I think xmtr is really less than 1 kw, and antenna is presumed to be a dipole. I will confirm this data. (Nigro-Uruguay) Update: Per technical person at xmtr site, they are using a 2x813 xmtr feeding a halfwave dipole with around 250 watts. Sked is 0950-0300, simulcasting MW 1050 (CX26). The media prgm, in SP, "Radioactividades," is b/c Sat and Sun at 1400-1500. For QSL purposes, you can send your rpts to Casilla 7011, Montevideo, and their E-mail is radioact@chasque.apc.org (Nigro-Uruguay)

VENEZUELA. 9750, R. Occidente at 1135 Aug 1. I've been hearing what I think is Voice of Malaysia some mornings on this fqy, but hrd this instead Aug 1 with a loud S8 signal. Sports rpt, plenty of ments. of Tovar, snippets of mx, ID in passing at 1150. QRM SSB comms. from "Domestic" doing a radio check at 1215. Formal ID with calls and fqys at 1220. (Novello-NC)
