

FAROE ISLANDS. New transmitter on Akraberg 531 kHz to come. Since May 6th **Kringvarp Faroya** has been silent on this frequency. The old transmitter went down due to technical problems caused by old technology, and was irreparable. It was considered, that the best and cheapest solution was to install a new transmitter. This will come into temporary use during August, and installing the new xmitter will be completed during last quarter of 2008. AUSTRALIA. Hi Glen[n], Radio Symban. Just to inform you and your fans, that 2368.5 is currently off air with an antenna problem The problem should be resolved with the next week or so. However, the tests are encouraging. Definately, Dxers in the USA and Finland have heard 2368.5 kHz (John Wright, Australian Radio DX Club, June 24, DX LISTENING DIGEST)

COLOMBIA. Re DXLD 8-035, 8-037, 8-057: unID Latin American on 2980:

I've posted three further audio clips to my folder from this presumed harmonic we first noted in March. These clips are from mid April, around 0800 UT (the file name provides exact time and date). The station would tend to play music through the top of the hour with no announcements until 2 to 5 minutes past the hour. Any help would certainly be appreciated. Sounds like Radio Vida Nueva midway on the 0802 clip. The first phone number mentioned at 0810 is 366 07 33. Its listed for Radio Vida Nueva in the yellow pages for Barranquilla. So I guess weve spotted the right station (Henrik Klemetz, Sweden, June 30, ibid.)

Thank you Henrik, for your fine job in definitively identifying this one. So it turns out your first suspicions in March proved to be correct. It's good to take this one off the unidentified list. Your help is much appreciated. 73, (Nigel Pimblett, AB, ibid.)

INDONESIA. 3987.03, RRI-Manokwari, 1347-1425, June 24, in BI, EZL songs, ToH song of Coconut Isles, 5 minutes of news, National Anthem, back to songs, weak. Checked after ToH and found // to RRI Fak Fak (4790.03). (Ron Howard, Asilomar Beach, CA, Etón E1, dxldyg via DX LISTENING DIGEST)

INDONESIA. 4790.03, RRI Fak-Fak, 1151-1210+ Jun 23. Indo vocal music hosted by YL; 1159 SCI; Jak news at 1200. Fair (John Wilkins, Wheat Ridge, Colorado. Drake R-8, 100-foot RW, Cumbredx via DXLD)

INDONESIA. 4869.91, RRI Wamena, (Tentative), 1045-1105 June 28. Just sitting here on the carrier from about 1045 when at 1049 I hear singing buried in the noise. Periodically it fades in to an audible level over the noise. This continues during the above listening period. The carrier as mentioned, is pretty clear, but audio needs help. At 1059 to the hour, interval signal heard. This was followed with a female talking. Then a male presents the news. Signal was threshold (Chuck Bolland, Clewiston, Florida, NRD545, dxldyg via DX LISTENING DIGEST)

ITALY: Radio Maria World Family decided to start a QSL service, as a friendly attention towards radio enthusiasts. So, after talks with Radio Maria WF President, Emanuele Ferrario, and Radio Maria WF Network Director, Claudio Re, I begun to confirm reports as QSL manager. It is a volunteer amateur service. So far we have QSL letter for Radio Maria Nederland 675 kHz and Radio Maria station in Andrate, Italy, on 26000 kHz AM and 26010 kHz DRM.

MYANMAR/BURMA [and non]. **9730.74, R. Myanma**, 1347-1512*, June 30, in vernacular (assume Burmese Service), long segments of talking with no music till sign-off, one portion had talk about "environmental" issues (the English word used many times), indigenous instrumental music at sign-off, QRM splatter from adjacent stations till 1357, then in the clear, signal gradually improving to almost good reception, not // 5985.0. Am grateful to Victor Goonetilleke of Sri Lanka for his tip for the sign-off time. Myanmar has still not returned to their pre-cyclone frequency of 5040.6, but did hear AIR-Jeypore on 5040.0 today from 1255-1315, in vernacular with subcontinent music and songs, fair-poor reception. Jeypore usually not heard this well (Ron Howard, Asilomar Beach, CA, Etón E1, dxldyg via DX LISTENING DIGEST)

PAPUA NEW GUINEA. I had a good look at the PNG stations and I heard these frequencies in the local evening in the period 0800-1400 UT. 3235, 3260, 3275, 3290, 3315, 3325, 3335, 3365, 3385 & 3905 kHz.

The strongest was Radio Central [sic: any ID as such heard?? gh], Port Moresby on 3290 kHz which seemed to abruptly end modulating the carrier at random times, although some days it made it to 1400. I think the transmitter may be on all night unmodulated as it was there in the morning still, but unused.

I heard these four station in the local morning from 1900: 3335, 3365, 3385 & 3905 kHz. 3335 kHz seemed to relay 585 kHz from Port Moresby in the mornings. 585 kHz was present throughout the day from 1900 to 1400.

I also heard Wantok Radio Light on 7325 kHz at various times, but never at good strength.

On medium wave I could hear two stations on 585 kHz, two on 900 kHz, the strongest being Radio East Highlands, Goroka, announcing as "KBK FM" and one on 1494 kHz that I believe is Radio Enga. In the past I have heard Radio Morobe, Lae on 810 kHz, but this time the frequency was totally dominated by RRI Merauke, Indonesian Papua which was very strong. I took along my Sony SW ICF7600G and 10 metres of antenna wire (Barry Hartley, NZ, touring Port Douglas, Queensland, June 28, wwdxc BC-DX TopNews July 3 via DXLD)

SOLOMON ISLANDS. Honiara on 1035 kHz was heard most local evenings in Port Douglas from around 0800 UT to after 1200, often mixed with 2ZB Wellington. I couldn't hear them on the other medium wave frequencies of 945 & 1386 kHz. 1035 kHz should be in \\ with 5020 kHz, but I never heard the short wave frequency, strangely! (Barry Hartley, NZ, touring Port Douglas, Queensland, June 28, wwdxc BC-DX TopNews July 3 via DXLD)

TAJIKISTAN. *"Hej Lars-Erik, Re: TAJIKISTAN. 4635 ofta 0100 Har inte IDat denna stn med bra styrka, förmodligen Dushanbe men stämmer inte med WRTH, skall kolla upp den men styrkan är på nedåtgående just nu. LES"*

There are two entries in WRTH for 4635 kHz: 0400-1000 and 1400-0400. There is an update on http://www.wrth.com/updates_national.html, which says 2300-2000. (73, Mauno via HCDX)
