Något som jag noterat efter en längre inaktiv period: Synen på piratstationer tycks ha ändrat sig radikalt i våra kretsar! Nordx vimlar av inlägg om olika kortvågspirater, om vilka som hörts, om hur man får tag i deras adresser och om vilka som svarar. I SWB var, för inte alltför länge sedan, piraternas verksamhet nästan tabu och de sågs mest som störande element utan egentlig existensberättigande. Att många rapporterade nya Peru- och Boliviastationer, av vilka många nog sände utan licens och egentligen också var att betrakta som pirater, var dock "en Gudi behaglig gärning" - ju fler och finare - desto bättre.

Det kändes nästan på gränsen till lite förnedrande att, i brist på andra tips, rapportera att man lyssnat på några pirater. För att inte tala om att rapportera att man fått QSL från någon av dem... Nej, så långt gick inte ens jag - då!

Nu då? Ja, det verkar helt OK att såväl rapportera tips på dem som att ta med dem i QSL-listan. Jag nöjer mig dock med QSL-en. Det känns ganska meningslöst att rapportera om pirater som hörts, eftersom de sände så oregelbundet och ofta flyttar sig.

**Christer Brunström: Radio Free Asia 11605** (Tinian) kort, **HCJB 5940 (Litauen)** tre snygga kort, **WWCR 15825** snyggt kort, **Free Radio Service Holland 7685** brev, kort och trevlig broschyr om stationens 30-åriga historia **Martien Groot**, Schoorl, Netherlands. I'm very curious to know if anyone has come any nearer to identifying the mystery station on 6075.72v. I have been doing some monitoring these past few days and found what must be the same UNID on slightly higher 6075.75 this morning (Sept 17) from 0249 on whereas they were definitely missing at around the same time on Sept. 14, 15 & 16. You must have read Glen Hauser's comment in DXLD suggesting that this might be "an unknown Brazilian". Is it, after all?

Ralph Perry had a UNID here on Sept 12 (see DXLD message #55417), in which he thought this one could be R Alvorada.

I have checked this frequency for a few months now but I haven't noticed any trace of R Alvorada lately.

I was very curious to know what they say in the ID so I sent the recording to Carlos Goncalves who is very familiar with Brazilian stations and of course the language. Here are his comments: *As to the R. Verdes Florestas audio clip, well, I was unable to understand many words of what they say, but did hear a few refs. to public stations, e.g. R N Amazônia, prior to their own fq announcement + ID + location. Voz do Brasil, de segunda a sexta-feira, às dezanove horas, ..., emissoras ... da EBC: (list of stns, check <http://www.ebc.com.br/> where you'll find them, though not exactly in the same order as heard in the ann.). EBC stands for Empresa Brasil de Comunicação. The 60 m band fq is announced as "quatro mil, oitocentos e sessenta e cinco", not setenta (70), but I admit it's not clear.*

*You may also find a bit strange that Brazilians often refer to "meia dúzia" when mentioning figure 6 - don't ask me why, it's just a [silly] habit among many of their other strange habits when speaking! This expression is more applied when the call signs are announced. I can't understand why on earth they do that because "seis", 6, is hardly confused with another figure, I mean it doesn't sound like any other, except perhaps if saying "dezaséis", 16.*

On Sept 17 at 2317 I was at last able to check the webstream audio and the station at the same time (now on 6075.42). The RKC webstream had several minutes of talk and at the same time the station had music. If the audio streams are // the delay would be max 10-30 seconds or so?? But definitely not in parallel at least at this time. The RKC webstream music was very Bolivian stylish and the music on 6075 was of completely different style. The mystery continues as it seems .... TN

She thanked the provincial administration for giving K7,000 to have the NBC studio cleaned up. She also thanked listeners in East Sepik and parts of West Sepik for their patience during the suspension of service.

### Re: A lot of Perseus SDRs for sale

**Let's be honest about it: Perseus is a terrible thing.** It receives too much, making us slave on large recordings to uncover obscure signals and identifications. And as if this wasn't enough, it makes you connect to other Perseis on the other side of the planet to do even more of the same. It makes you a slave of your listening habit. With it you can listen (and re-listen) twenty four hours a day and not be finished yet. I wonder how many Perseus widows there are out there. Maybe it is they who should start a separate group.

But as most of you know, listening is only the tip of the iceberg: what about all the connections it forces you to use to decode this and that on your computer? Is there anything it doesn't make you listen to? What about all those programs and the interfaces it forces you to use? Just put the DLL in the right place, you think, and I'm done. Wrong: it's a never-ending road, with programs good at this and good at that, new versions and features - you can spend endless hours discovering new things. And if you are any good in programming and the like, then you are definitely hooked: everything you see and you don't see is an invitation to make something in any way you can.

Be warned: other SDRs are as bad. I have another couple of these and they cause the same problems too. It takes ages to learn how to use one of them for the things you want and then you can't let go - or, even worse, you try to do the same with the others. Your life is gone, it has become a bottomless pit of new opportunities and challenges. I guess that's what they call hell on earth. I guess we were much happier many years ago when all we had to wrestle with were wires, soldering irons and -I almost forgot- overpriced, mediocre receivers. Ah, the good old times.

The only positive side to Perseus and its ilk is that they allow you to make proper use of your computer: solve hardware problems, identify software conflicts, learn how to install stuff under new operating systems. But, to be brutally honest, text processors, spreadsheets, internet browsers and other common, general purpose software (not to mention computers, pads, smartphones, routers etc.) perform the same useful function.

So join the Perseus Liberation Front and get rid of your SDRs for as low a price as you can in order to undermine the devious developers. For my part, I would welcome a second Perseus and an FM+ for peanuts.

## Perseus removed by anti-virus again...

**Hello, Just for info, for Nico and others, I have had this with Avast Free edition**, although it doesn't report a specific problem, it just asks if you want to run the Perseus .EXE in a Sandbox. (Perseus 0b, DLL version 3.5)

General info: There is little to worry about as it is not detecting an actual 'trojan' in the Perseus software, but the behaviour of the app on startup, looks that way, for example, calling home to check for updates or for serial verification and the like, listening on a port for inbound connections is the most probable one here as the new network feature allows remote connections to your radio. This is triggering 'Trojan-like' behaviour.

Here's a description from F-Secure's website for such a generic function.

**"Additional Details: Trojan:W32/Generic is a Generic Detection that identifies files with trojan-like characteristics or behavior.**

**About Generic Detections: Unlike more traditional detections (also known as signatures or single-file detections) a Generic Detection does not identify a unique or individual malicious program. Instead, a Generic Detection looks for broadly applicable code or behaviour characteristics that indicate a file as potentially malicious, so that a single Generic Detection can efficiently identify dozens, or even hundreds of malware."**

Different AV software handles this 'behaviour' in different ways, as I said earlier, Avast asks if you want to run the application in a 'sandbox', which detects any ports opening, registry entries etc. that the application attempts to make and gives you the option of evaluating and accepting those changes or not.

Other AV software manufacturers attempt to quarantine the file because the developers don't quite know what to do with it as it can't be 'cleaned' because it is generic, even though a Trojan hasn't actually been detected. Doh!

Careful evaluation of how various AV software handles this type of detection should be made before handing over good money to the AV companies! Thumbs up to Avast's sandbox in this case.

As a software developer, believe me, it can be really damaging for a product to have these kinds of false positives deleting your app just because the AV companies can't really handle it properly.

Unless an actual Trojan is found by your AV software (i.e. not 'Generic'), it is normally safe to always allow or to put it in your 'whitelist' depending on your antivirus software, but that is your call!

Rant over! Hope that helps. Don't be paranoid, but it good to be cautious.
