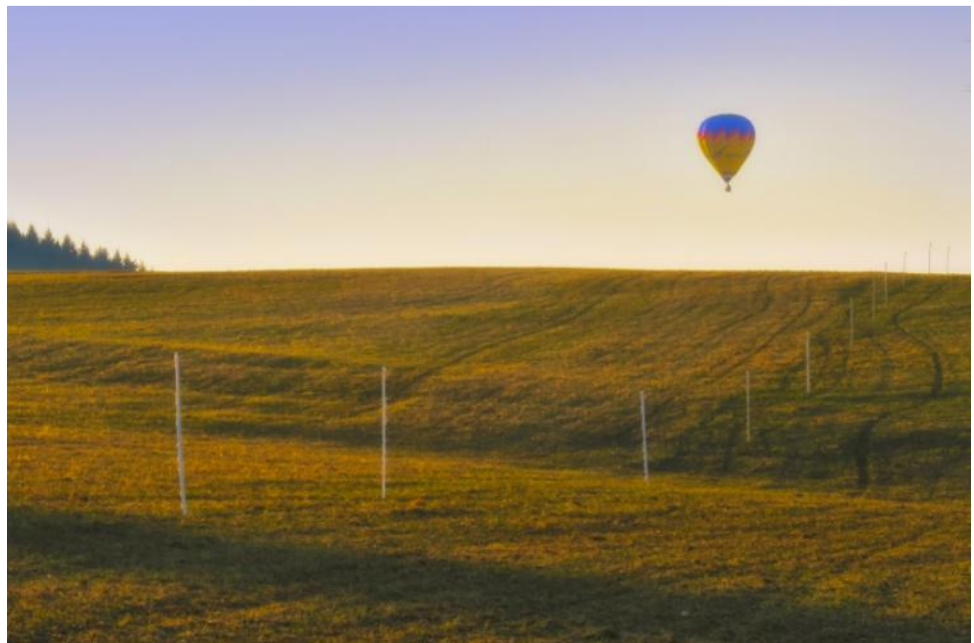

Analyzing Solar Eclipse with SDR-Radio.com - some results

Hi - during Solar Eclipse, I took a recording of the range from 0 to 2 MHz. After that, I analyzed these data with the module "SDR Data File Analyzer".

By this tool:

- * it was possible to separate many stations on one nominal channel in order to get the signal traces per defined station (and not the sum level of many stations on one channel) and
- * to visualize the signal level over time per station (Signal History)

I wrote down some results of this, including 29 Figures and three audio samples to let hear the enhancement. This PDF may be downloaded from folder "DK8OK" in the file's section of this group.

Korruption!

Den synnerligen kommunikativa Drita Cico vid Radio Tirana har bidragit med följande:

As you may or may not be aware be Chinese President Xi Jinping is on a corruption crackdown. This crackdown is going after every part of the government. Including three important arms of the government; CCTV, Xinhua and CRI.

This morning I got an email from a friend at CRI who told me in the last 3 weeks another 18 managers have been suspended for using state funds for personal gain.

1. The head of the CRI motor pool was caught using CRI cars with friends for a private taxi service using the Uber app.
2. Another manager at China Radio International Television (no one has ever seen CRI TV). Has been caught using CRI equipment for producing porn movies that were being sold on line thought a Chinese website.
3. Two more vice-presidents have been caught at submitting over 300,000USD in receipts from "lady bars".
4. A manger was caught to have taken 1 million over 5 years to pay for a bar that he owned in the Sanlitun bar area of Beijing. They also discovered 7 women from Vietnam working there. Also bribes paid to the local police station.
5. The head of CRI publishing company was discovered to have his hand in the till. Skimming nearly 250,000USD over 2 years.
6. One was the owner of a ghost company that provided visas to anyone who would be willing to pay 300USD per visa.

A team of investigators have set up an office at CRI on the 6th floor.

This is only the tip of the iceberg. Just before Chinese New Year some managers were caught organizing sex parties for leaders of CCTV and CRI.

There is a new blackout, but it seems to have no effect. Sina Weibo the Chinese version of twitter has have people post there about this. It's amusing.

Nåja, vi i Sverige ska kanske inte slå oss för bröstet. Nyheter från Tjeckien denna vecka, eller hur? Och som i Kina kanske vi måste säga "This is only the tip of the iceberg"??

BYE BYE BELARUS

För några år sedan besökte Bengt Ericson och jag Vitryssland på inbjudan av Radio Belarus. Det var en lyckad resa, vi blev väl omhändertagna och miljön i Minsk var angenäm, en vacker stad med många parker och ett behagligt lugn. Visst var vi medvetna om att vi befann oss i en diktaturstat, men den föreföll vara av det mildare slaget. Vi beslöt av t emot vår kontaktperson på Radio Belarus, Larisa Suarez, för ett besök här i Sverige, och genom fint samarbete mellan dx-are i Stockholm, Norrköping och Småland blev också Larisas resa i Sverige lyckad - reserapporten kan studeras i ett äldre nummer av Eter-Aktuellt.

Sedan dess har det hårdnat. Relationerna mellan Belarus och EU-länderna, då inte minst Sverige, har utmärkts av

friktioner och konfrontationer. Ett annat irritationsmoment för mig som dx-are har varit det usla samarbetet mellan tekniker och programfolk på Radio Belarus. Påpekanden om stark överton från MV 1170 kHz föll inte vederbörande tekniker på läppen - ingen åtgärd. Vanligt förekommande avbrott i internetsändningen av Radio Belarus engelska program lördagar-söndagar har föranlett många klagomål från min sida - även i den saken har det varit segt. Och förslag om en repris vid lunchtid på 11730 kHz av kvällssändningen på engelska som hörs mycket dåligt på kortväg möttes av tummen ner.

Nåja, att det finns friktioner mellan tekniker och programfolk är sannerligen inte ovanligt, Nils-Olof Franzéns bok *Radiominnen* ger talande bevis på relationsproblem mellan Telegrafverket och Radiotjänst på sin tid.... här i lyckolandet Sverige....

Men i fråga om Radio Belarus skulle det bli bara värre. När det andra veckohelgen i följd inte fanns någon internet-sändning av Larisas brevlådeprogram rann sinnet på mig (efter att ha kollat att Minsk FM och andra kommersiella sändare gick på webben men inte den statliga radion) och jag skrev till Larisa att de som producenter och presentatörer inte borde tolerera att sitta och jobba med program som sedan inte går ut till lyssnarna - om så behövs borde ni protestera hos A.L. själv, skrev jag. Och därmed hade jag tydligen gått över gränsen. Mitt mail hade lästs av andra och setts som uppvigling!

Tänk att jag kunde vara så dum, trots många års kontakter och förvecklingar med Enver Hoxhas Albanien! Tänk att jag inte insåg ännu en gång att med en diktatur leker man inte! Det som hände var att mina mail kom tillbaka flera gånger med notering av "Postmaster" (=censuren) att adressen suarez@radio.tvr.by inte är unik! Naturligtvis en ren lögn, dessutom klumpig. E-mail har ju gått fram på den adressen tidigare. Larisa, tidigare gift med en latinamerikan, har ett i Minsk troligen unikt efternamn....

Försök med radions allmänna e-mailadress misslyckades också. Där blev svaret att mailet inte levererades "for policy reasons." Jo men visst, men snarare "for political reasons"!

Så för min del är det "bye bye Belarus". Som lyssnare får man antingen hålla god min i elakt spel eller finna sig i att bli blockerad. Efter att ha stött mig med regimen i Tirana och blivit placerad i kylskåp i årtal borde jag begripit det. Stor tok blir efterklok!

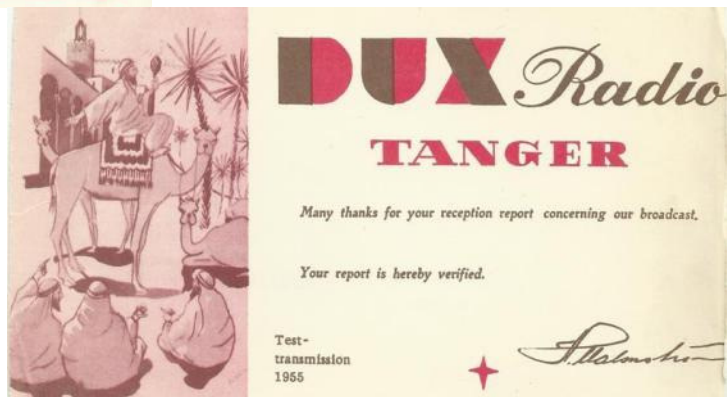
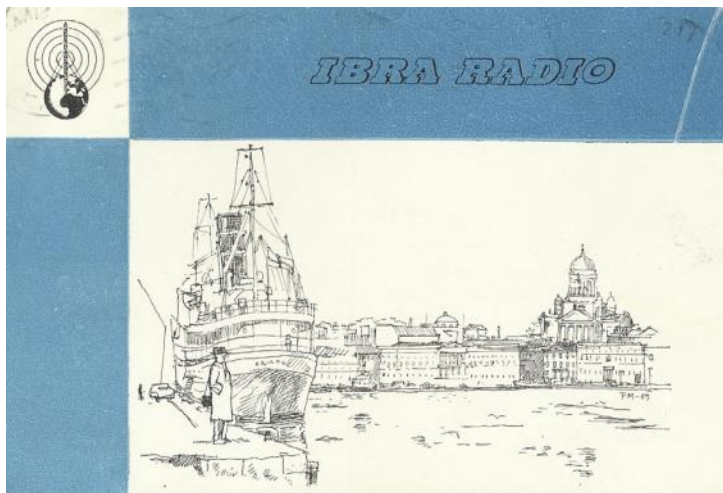
