15 MHz bandwidth on HF: Reception, recording, playing and analyzing

Hi - SDRs give us the chance to receive, record, play and analyze wide frequency ranges. The width is a trade-off of resolution (in bit) and transfer rates via the SDR's interface and/or writing to hard disk.

Recently, I connected the ELAD's FDM-S2 to one PC to achieve a combined bandwidth of 18,3 MHz, of which nearly 15 MHz are alias-free / at 16 bit resolution.

All went smoothly. Many hours were recorded in a row. Playing and analyzing of this rather wide range has been made with Simon Brown's "File Analyzer" (free).

For all avid listeners, this approach provides new horizons - whether they are listening to broadcast, amateur radio and especially utility radio stations. It provides parallel recording of e.g. alls broadcast bands from 90 m to 16 m or all ham radio bands from 80 m through 17 m - and each kHz in between.

Intruder watch can be maintained on a professional level, as reception of many broadcasting stations in parallel or the scattered activity of utility stations comes to reality.

The general concept has been laid down in a 7-paged PDF "3 x ELAD FDM-S2", hosted at Christoph Ratzler's (OE2CRM) A-DX website: http://ratzer.at/pdf/ELAD_15MHz_DK8OK.pdf

The DJ Who Shook the Soviet Union With Jazz

Voice of America DJ Willis Conover is up for a postage stamp to honor his work in exporting jazz, especially to short-wave radio listeners in the old Soviet Bloc, as Doug Ramsey at The Wall Street Journal notes. A stamp would be a minimal tribute, given the remarkable role Conover played during the Cold War, though it would be just about the only "official" recognition he has ever received.

During Conover's four decades as a Voice of America (VOA) DJ from 1955 through the mid-1990s, he upended communist cultural policy just by playing prohibited "degenerate" American music that his overseas audience longed to hear. Most Americans have never heard of him, but in the postwar era he was one of the best-known, and certainly one of the most popular, Americans in the world. He had millions of devoted followers in Eastern Europe alone; his worldwide audience in his heyday has been estimated at up to 30 million people.

Conover managed to tour Soviet Bloc cities occasionally during East-West thaws, and, to his great surprise, was greeted at airports like a celebrity by huge cheering crowds. Moscow cabdrivers recognized him solely on the basis of his distinctive baritone voice.....

All Catholic Dioceses to Own Radio Stations By 2020, Bishop Says

Nairobi — All Catholic dioceses in Kenya will own radio stations by 2020, Bishop Joseph Obanyi, Chairman of the Kenya Conference of Catholic Bishops (KCCB) Commission for Social Communications has said.

"Our aim is to see spiritual and social transformation of people, we want to see integral transformation of the human person as a result of strong Catholic media presence," Bishop Obanyi told CISA August 7.

Bishop Obanyi said that the radio stations set-up is a result of the "demand by the faithful to have their own medium of communication within their reach and also to ensure progressive evangelization."

He added that the radio stations will broadcast in either Kiswahili or the local languages depending on the target audience.

"We can never be certain on which language the radio stations will broadcast, this will depend on the communities in the diocese on their own medium of communication," said Bishop Obanyi of the Catholic Diocese of Kakamega.

Presently the Catholic Church in Kenya has radio stations including Nairobi (Radio Waumini), Nakuru (Radio Amani), Lodwar (Radio Akicha), Murang'a (Radio Maria) Kitui (Radio Thome) and Isiolo (Radio Shahidi).

The Church in Kenya plan to expand growth in the media is contained in the Waumini Communications strategic plan 2016-2020 dubbed "WAUMINI.COM 2020" that seek to create development of a countrywide community media and ICT sector.

Bishop Obanyi said that the strategic plan would create sustainable, strategic and innovative future for Waumini Communications.

Waumini Communications Limited is the Social Communications arm of the KCCB. The company was set up in 2012 by the bishops to coordinate and facilitate Catholic Media in Kenya.
