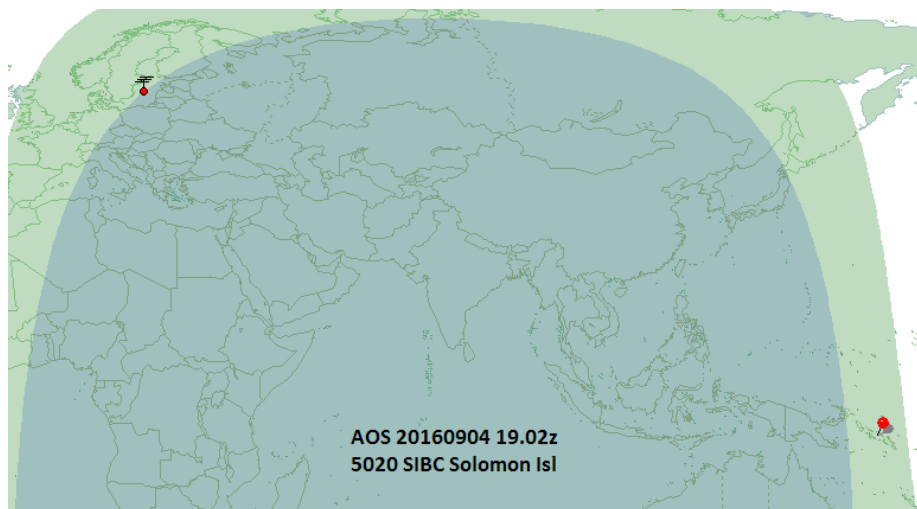

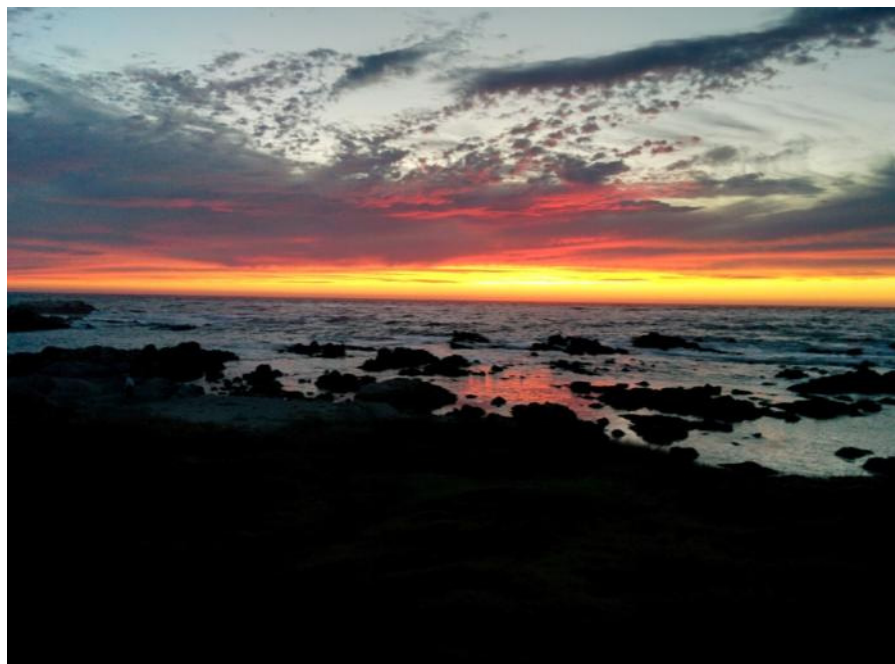

NOTICIARIO CLANDESTINO by Steve Reinstein

La Voz de Sandino - 6227v, continues to be hrd 0000, 0400, & 1100, despite the recently published announcement by Edén Pastora Gómez (Comandante Cero) that he has disbanded his group Frente Revolucionario Sandino. Several mos ago the FRS appeared to have been strengthened when exiled former Nicaraguan junta member Alfonso Robelo publicly announced his intent to join forces with Pastora. Robelo is the leader of the Movimiento Democrático Nicaragüense. Pastora, never a friend of the U.S., is upset that he is not receiving U.S. aid in his cause to overthrow the 9 member Sandinista ruling junta. U.S. aid is apparently channeled to the Honduran based group of former Nicaraguan National Guardsmen, the Fuerza Democrática Nicaragüense (the people who are kind enough to give us Radio Quince de Septiembre). Speaking of Sept 15th, anyone hear any unusual clandestine activity this day?

Radio Quince de Septiembre - 5560, 0650-0700*, never hrd this late before, on 8/29, tho I'm not usually awake at this hour to check. No //s noted and this freq heavily jammed till 0659 when the Nicaraguan anthem commenced. Seems that the Sandinistas don't like jamming their own anthem!

La Voz del CID - The CID stations on 4980, 5106, 7355, & 7412, have all been noted using their new separate IDs (c.f. DXSF#15) in addition to "a traves la cadena radial de C.I.D." The 4980 relay via Ecos del Torbes, San Cristóbal, has again deleted the freq annmnt of 4980 from the ID tape. Obviously this is no coincidence, since they did this before on the old ID tape. There remains a 3-4 second blank spot where "4980" should be. Guess the management of Ecos del Torbes is reluctant to inform listeners to the CID pgm, just what freq they're tuned to....Full data prepared QSL cd rcvd in 24 days from Venezuela, for 1½ hours of details on the 5106 xmsn. Sent rpt to Apartado 76633, El Marques, Caracas. Reply came from Ap. 60774, Caracas 1060. v/s Roberto Fontanillas-Roig, Delegado en Venezuela. Also rcvd info sheet which lists the 7355 xmsn as "R. Antonio Guiteras". No wonder why nobody ever hrd of 'Videras'! And ofcourse, rcvd 10 page booklet "Huber Matos; un destino y su razón". No reply as yet from the 2 Miami addresses.

Radio Cuba Libre - 6990 f/d ppd cd rcvd in 15 days from Movimiento Demócrata Cristiano, Centro de Información Difusión y Opinión Pública, Box 557759, Miami, FL33155. Also rcvd nice MDC keychain, sticker of Cuban flag, poster of Cuban political prisoner Jorge Valls, 12 page brochure "Reporte DCuba", 4 pager "Declaración del XXII Congreso", and finally, handwritten request in EG for a copy of my 8/9/81 tape of Radio Cuba Libre. QSL was stamped MDC.

Ramón Sánchez, head of Organización Para la Liberación de Cuba, supposedly operates a paramilitary training camp in the everglades, and bcsts to Cuba. Anyone ever hear of an anti-Castro cland claiming affiliation with OPLC? Could La Juventud Progresista Cubana be connected w/OPLC. Or, is it merely coincidence that LJPC has the same initials as La Junta Patriótica Cubana, (who sporadically operate Radio Mambi/LV de la JPC)?
