RUSSIA. End of Radio Rossii on SW and MW. Actually the news releases from the Vladivostok branch of RTRS describe all the background, making further speculations (such as the election one) unnecessary:

So destructions had, usually through loss of mains power, knocked off a number of DVB-T transmission facilities, leaving 45 settlements with altogether 33,000 inhabitants without a signal.

After the state of emergency had been declared on 31 Aug RTRS had 810 kHz back on air the following night at 1 AM, as shown at <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=EBp-NoWuYCO> Shortwave transmissions apparently required more preparations, they finally started in the local morning of 3 Sep.

On 17 Sep at 11 AM all transmitter sites were back on air, where needed with portable generating sets. It was decided to continue the AM contingency service for another week and then stop it.

Propagation Indicator added to the RF-Seismograph

Hi Everybody; The MDSR Team has again come up with a cool new way to indicate band activity. We were able to extract the signal from the noise and and display the results in gray scale vertical lines (white is best propagation). This display is different from the noise level graph because it does not indicate changes in noise level and only indicates activity. This makes it easier to determine which band is open.

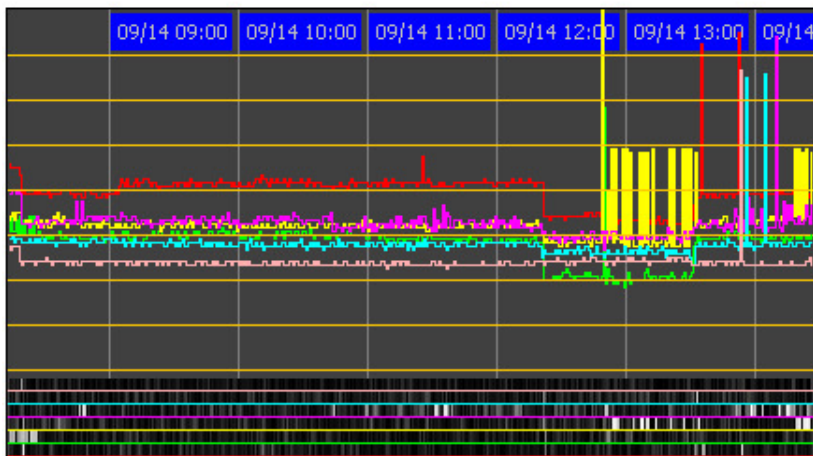
Now that we can separate the noise from the signals we can develop a notification system that sends an e-mail if there is propagation. Never miss an band-opening again!
