

Further to Ron Howard's recent posting, last week was my first opportunity to try for the new transmissions from Radio Pitumarca and it is providing reasonable reception in New Zealand from morning sign-on. Frequency quite steady on 4930.601 KHz.

The transmitter appears to operate according to an automated schedule, powering up at 0930:10 on each weekday monitored so far.

The actual broadcast feed starts abruptly at various times this week - as early as 0930:44

yesterday 27 October, but as late as 0947 earlier in the week. Programme consists initially of Andean rhythms with an occasional time check and identification, but by about 0950 programming gets more lively with recorded identifications and some commercial content.

So, we know for sure that Jaguar will work with IQ recordings made from the RSPdx and RSPDuo in HSDR-Perseus format. What else is there?

Elad made a dll for allowing HSDR to work with the FDM-S2. So presumably, Jaguar is compatible.

Not so for the FDM-S3, as already noted in comments. I have serious doubts it will ever happen.

The unbranded RX-888 wil presumably work with Jaguar via HSDR.

The Winradio G31DDC and G33DDC are interesting because they are high-performing radios with 16-bit ADCs. RadioJet made HSDR-dlls for both, but a very long time ago, and both were limited to 1 MHz sampling. I tested the G31 dll today, and was able to record, but as expected the limited frequency range did not play with Jaguar.

There is however a proper dll for the G33DDC, developed in 2019. I was quite active on the "persuasion side", and the plan was to finish a G31DDC dll as well. However, it never materialized as far as I know. I presume that the unofficial G33DDC dll will work - I sold off the one I had so can't confirm.

The limited bandwidth would likely also prevent the Airspy HF+ from working with Jaguar.

HSDR has a long list of SDRs that may work with the software, most of them are unknown to me. [HSDR - Hardware](#). I suppose most of them are irrelevant for us.

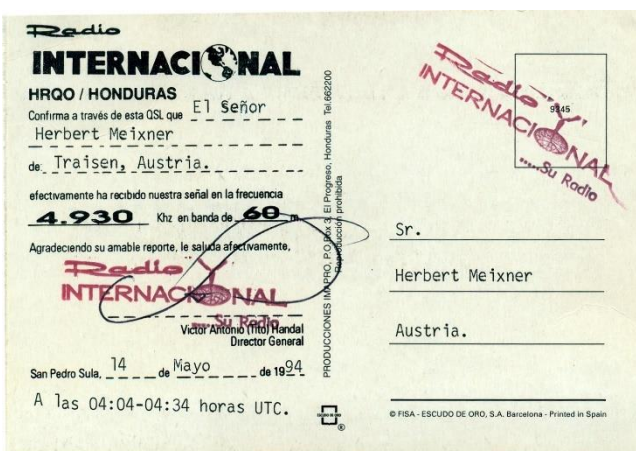
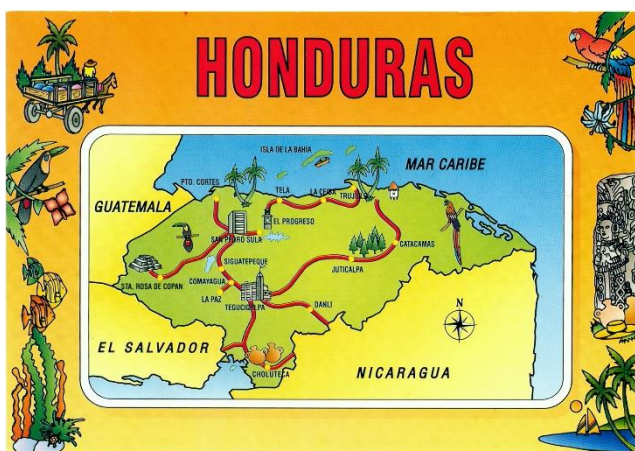

Virtually everyone in San Marcos de Caiquín knows Martina López – or at least her voice. After all, the 37-year-old was the first female presenter to work for Radio Comunitaria Tenán, a free, indigenous broadcasting station based in western Honduras.

What is unique about this particular radio station is the area it covers: it operates from the heart of the Cacique Lempira – Señor de las Montañas biosphere reserve, which is home to around 30,000 people, of which 30 per cent – including López herself – are ethnic Lenca. This is a fairly isolated region.

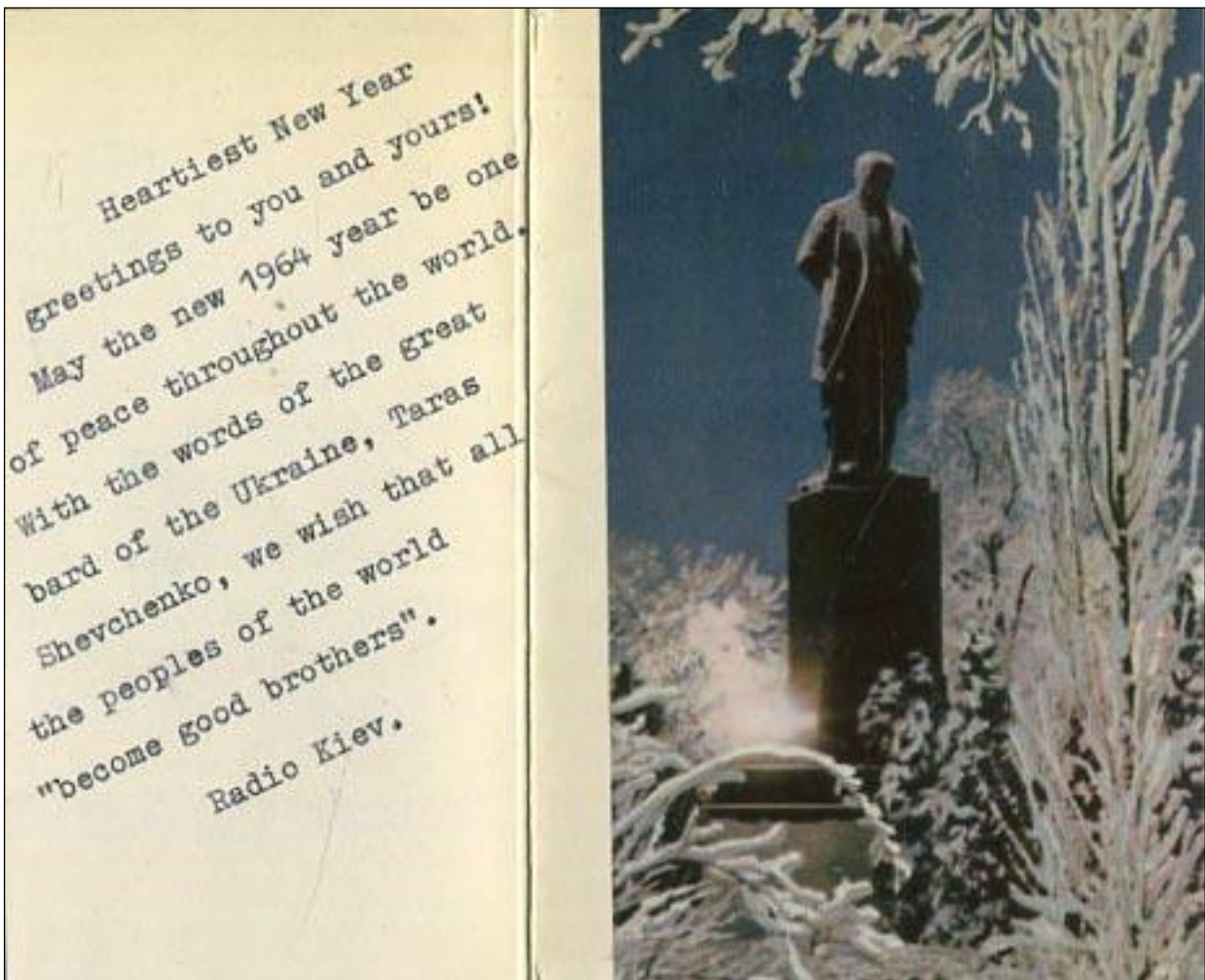

DX nostalgia by RFK

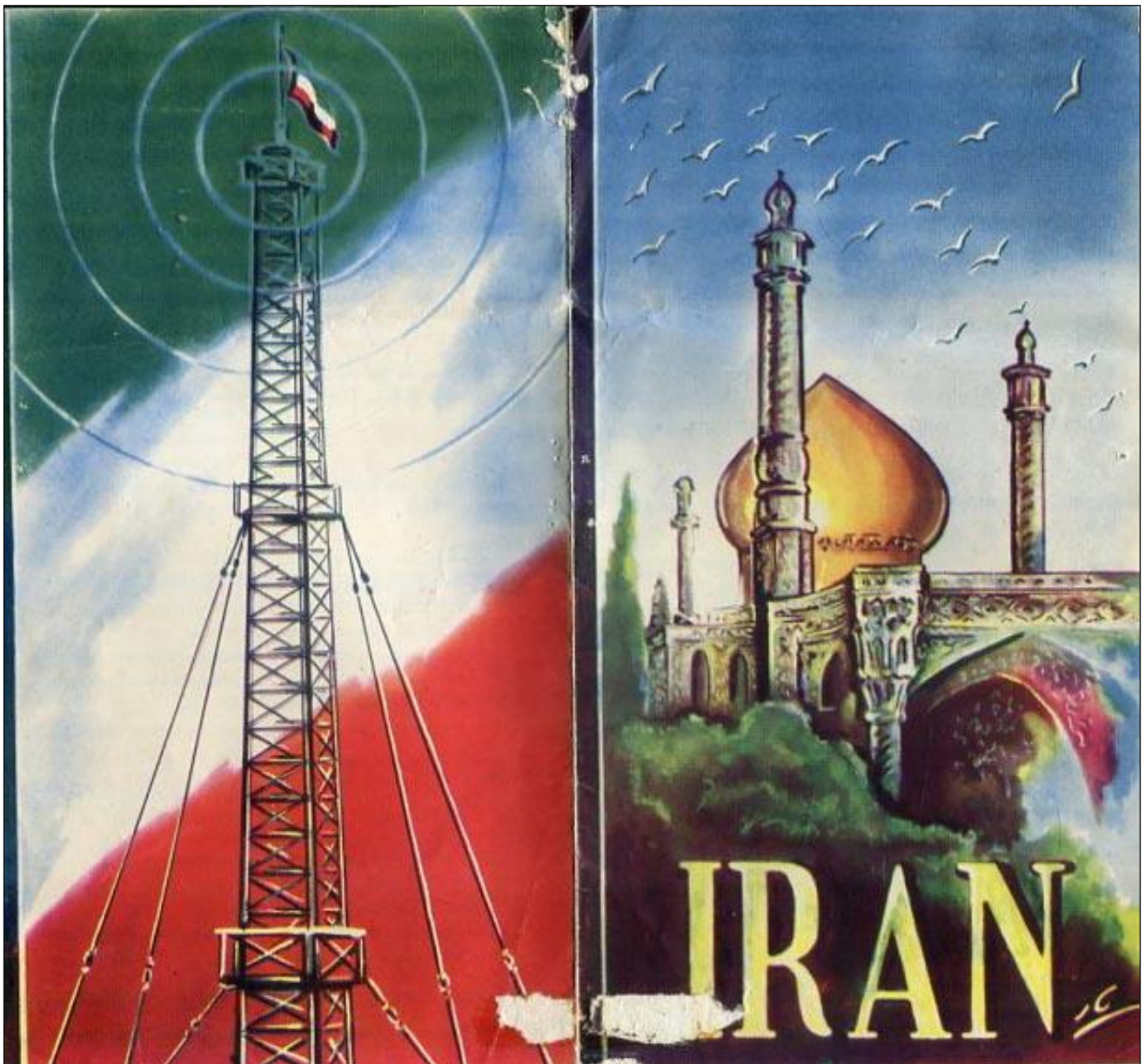
