Time to change from monthly SWI to one every second week, so please note next stopdate! Soon something most surely will happen on the bands, now is the time to check them very carefully. (I too am ready after a long relaxing period from DX-ing). Juan has sent us his last report from Peru, he is now in Switzerland.

REPORT FROM PERU part XXIII (final, Feb 16-March 17) ALL TIMES IN UTC

- 2499.9H R Estacion Frontera, Cobija, Pando, Bolivia heard here March 13, confirming that this stn broadcasts on MW 1250 kHz. ID: "1250 khzts, banda de 240 metros, OM, una voz en la frontera, centinela de la nacionalidad".
- 3933 R "El Porvenir", El Porvenir, Huamachuco, La Libertad, Peru. This is a new ID and a new QTH for this one. Announcing studios in Calle Hermanos Sangreñ (tent.) 424, El Porvenir. Begins an evangelical music prgrm at 0200. ID also as "R.E.P."
- 4145.0 R Gran Pajateñ, Celendin, Peru is again in this range, with the old trmtr. Heard March 16 at 0305, however next day in 4181 variable.
- 4501.3 My UNID here is R Galaxia, Guayaramerin, Bolivia (x5161.8/Dec). In this channel however, very difficult reception due to heavy RTTY QRM.
- 5340 R Cochan, Cochan, Cajamarca, Peru. This trmtr reactivated! Earlier known under several other names & locations, and now this name. Heard at first check March 14 at 0212. ID 0215: "9 de la noche con 10 minutos, en R Cochan momentamente, en senal de prueba, y ya nos dirigimos al bello distrito de Llapa, como esta la gente linda de Llapa, muchos saludos para todos ustedes...". The town of Cochan (complete name is San Silvestre de Cochan) is a few kilometers away from the trmtrs last QTH: San Miguel de Pallagues. This stn also uses the same version of El Condor Pasa, as all earlier stns did, at the beginning & end of transmission.
- 5350.0 R Comuneros, Asuncion, Paraguay. Again heard this paraguayean, now iding as this. Nearly no carrier, mostly USB. Should of course be a feeder, but who knows? (Check below for more adding info)
- 5529.1 UNID Cajamarcan stn, Peru heard here distorting March 10 at 2110.
- 6340.OH R La Voz del Valle, Punata, Cochabamba, Bolivia heard at first check March 8 at 2320, with mexican boleros, late argentine zambas, so possibly a bolivian stn. Possible the long inactive harmonic from this MW-stn. ID 2337 confirmed this. Remember, this is 4th harmonic 1585x4 !
- 6428.3 R Espinar, Espinar, Cuzco, Peru reactivated. Heard March 9 with a "aficionados" singer program. Regular signal.
- 6562.8 R Tacna, Tacna, Peru is now heard in // with 9486.0. Both frequencies with about the same power here in Lima.
- 6577.9 R Omega, "RG", Guachanama, Loja, Ecuador heard here March 10 with "mensajes musicales" format, ecuadorian music. However at 0052 again the old canned echo-effected ID as R La Voz de la Juventud, so they revert back to the old name??
- 6648.5 R Santa Cruz, Santa Cruz, Cajamarca, Peru announces that its owner is Mario Centurion Burga, that is also the owner of the stn broadcasting in 5340, with different names, in the past, and at one time with the name of Santa Cruz. This explains why this stn uses that name now. Also plays the same recording of El Condor Pasa as the stn on 5340 uses. Cd 0403 March 14.
- 6791.5 R Selecta C y D, Viru, La Libertad, Peru. First heard with very powerful signal, very clear modulation, but not so powerful audio. At 0005 some IDs impossible to sort out. Variety of peruvian music: huaynos, cumbias, andinas, etc. Seems well established because the commercials going for 10 minutes or so. Cd at 0456. Some heard IDs: "R Selecta de Viru", "...En su sintonia, R Selecta de Viru, banda internacional de 45 metros, Amplitud Modulada". Also IDs C y D, perhaps meaning Comercial y Difusora.
- 6815.6 R Universo, Santa Rosa, Cajamarca, Peru. Messages to people in the Bagua Chica area 0020 Feb 27. Very poor during mic tirades, though respectable in the music punches. Lots of huaynos, pasillos, and some cumbias. Gone at 0200 check. March 1 heard the cd at 0205 with national anthem.
- 11735.1 R Oriental, Montevideo, Uruguay. Contradicting my former reports, this SW-trmtr now is used by this stn, as heard with clear ID March 10, closing abruptly at 2100 (x Monte Carlo)

Em ondas tropicais, tres mil duzentos e oitenta e cinco kilohertz, R Bandeirantes de Cachoeira Paulista SP. Transmitindo em nome do Senhor"(Gospel stn). Note the different names for MW&SW. Reports to CP 15 - 12630 Cachoeira Paulista SP. V/s Maria Izabel Guatura (Secretary). ARM via OA
- 3375 R Dourados closed on March 31st (It is a pity). Delete this one. Still available in MW 720 kHz.
- 3375 R Educadora, Guajara Mirim transmits 0900-2200 according to CRM
- 4945 R Nacional, Porto Velho Sun 0800-0100 Feb. 85
- 6065 R Nacional da Amazonia Home Service: //11780

CLANDESTINE Colombia? Noted 2112-2149cd idying "La Voz de las Fuerzas Armadas Revolucionarias de Colombia/Radio Maquisaria". Political talk, some mx. 2146 mentions of power and frequencies, but unquoteable due to fading. 2147 cd with the Colombian national anthem. David Crawford in DXSF

Guatemala UNID located "just south of Guatemala City" according to the FCC. First noted by Steve Reinstein on 7360 March 21 0145. Noted on 7400 on regular basis since then. Noted 23rd and 28th -0200cd. This one also noted on 9920 with test tones from 1245. Tape often including "Nat King Cole en espanol".

PARAGUAY 5350 Emisoras Paraguay 0020-0132cd. LSB-feeder tnx to tip from Nick Pappas. LAM-pops at tune in, then "Emisoras Paraguay"-ID at 0030 & into list of stns carrying the program. Reinstein in DXSF
