AUSTRALIA

The three stations VL8A, Alice Springs VL8T, Tennant Creek and VL8K, Katherine were started to cover the vast area of Central and North Western Australia. The majority in this area were of aboriginal extraction, so programs were developed for, produced and spoken by them. Thus, of the 19 hrs of daily trmsn, 12 hrs of transmission time from both VL8A and VL8T, are for the aborigine community of Central Australia. There is not quite as much aboriginal programming from VL8K as the coastal languages of the north are dissimilar and therefore Central Australia programs cannot be used. Efforts are being made to increase suitable language programs for the coastal area to or near 12 hrs daily already operating in Alice Springs & Tennant Creek. CLANDESTINE (KOREA)

73 de SB until next month, and back to work

The following is some information regarding clandestine broadcasters in Korea as provided by Toru Yamashita and translated into English from Korean by Bill Harms.

1. The transmitter for the 4120 kHz channel that "Ku-gug-e Sori Pangsong" (or the "Voice of Saving the Nation", "Voice of National Salvation" or the "Voice of Nation Saving") has started to use recently is the same one that is being used for the "Korean Central Broadcast Station" (KCBS) on 9665 kHz.

When "T'ong-il Hyŏngmyŏngdang-e Mok-sori" (or the "Voice of the Revolutionary Party for Reunification") was on 4120 kHz it used the 6250 kHz "Pyongyang Broadcast Station" transmitter, but now the "Pyongyang Broadcast Station" shares its 6250 kHz transmitter with "Minjung e Me-ari Pangsong" or the "Echo of the Masses" on 5885 kHz.

2. "Hŭimang-e Meari Pangsong" (or "Radio Echo of Hope") is known to be broadcast from Kimp'o (near Seoul in Kyŏnggi Province).

* Note: The diacritical mark [˘] is important to include.
