4820.8 Atahualpa R., Peru, signs on irregularly at any time between 0950 and 1050. Their first programme of the day is "Amanecer andino" (viz. on 3rd Aug.) hosted by a fast-talking speaker. The signal is very good in Bogotá. As the stn is inaudible at night, I conclude that they are off the air at that time.

4824.5 La V de la Selva, Peru, is sometimes in sort of a skip zone until approx. 1100 when they start their newscast "El informativo Encuentro". The first programme of the day, starting at 1000, and presented by Pedro "Pepón" Sandoval Guzmán, is called "El amanecer amazónico" and/or (yes, he uses the two names indistinctly) "Baila baila tan riquita, moviéndose la colita." Within this programme there is an educational feature on farming, at 1030-1045v, called "Mi chacra chulla chulla".

4826.3 R Sicuani, Peru, "en la nueva era de la comunicación", in Aymara, with occasional slogans in Spanish, is in the clear up until 1030 approx., depending on La V de la Selva's skip-in time.

4899.8 R La Hora, Peru, is on this frequency since 22nd July at least.

4926.5v R San Miguel, Bolivia, now celebrating its "bodas de plata" (25th anniversary). In their morning newscast, "La V de la Selva" 1005-1035v, programme host Amador Cárdenas said he had received a cultural magazine from Santa Ana de Yacuma, called "El Movima". This magazine was sent to him by a friend, Mariano Verdugo Olmos, a "riberalteño" who works with this magazine, which was published in time for the "Fiesta Movima", starting 26th June. (Incidentally, the very same date was chosen by the Catholic stn on 4903.9, for their "Misión católica" campaign [cf. my report in last issue of RNM]. This stn is still audible until 0045/0100v s/off with the Lord's prayer, "el Padrenuestro" in Spanish).

4953 R Madre de Dios with a reasonably good signal around 1045 with their "Alegre amanecer" programme (same programme title used for programme on R Tarma, 4775.0, at the same time). Uses slogan "la voz al **servicio del pueblo**" and "su emisora amiga".

4965.4 R Santa Fé, Colombia, reactivated 9th or 10th August. First info came on the phone from J E Österholm, Finland! The signal in Finland is strong and clear.

5075 Caracol, Colombia, at 0915, after "Cuarto de hora Caracol" newscast, resuming "Amanecer AM" hosted by Germán Díaz Sossa. Some mornings, at 0930/0945, special letter-box feature called "DX Internacional".

6137.5 La V del Alto Mayo, Nueva Cajamarca, Peru, "la radio imperial de la sintonía internacional", "la radio más radio" etc. say. they are on the air 16 hours a day. During the 19th anniversary celebrations of the foundation of Nueva Cajamarca (date of foundation, acc. to the stn, 29th June 1974) they said that the actual population figure is 26,000. They also said that they were returning to the air after many years of "having kept the transmitter stowed away". The morning programme, during which they greeted American DXers Valko and Johnson, is called "Expresión de los pueblos andinos". The address has been given on the air as Av. Cajamarca km. 460, "extremo norte de Nueva Cajamarca". - Programmes in the evening are as follows per my own listening: 2000 "Voz y sentir del Ecuador" (Ecuadorian pasillos), 2100 "Rocío tropical" (chicha and cumbia), 2200 "Acuarela mexicana" (rancheras), 2300 "Proyección andina" (huaynos), 2400 "Integración juvenil" (rock and juvenile music). I'm not sure when they s/off, as the QRM gets the better of this stn after midnight.

9717.2 Correction to my item on R La Plata "La V de la Capital", Bolivia, in DXLD #40. The slogan used is "ondas de oro", as Santiago San Gil rightly mentions, not "ondas de hoy". "Oro" is of course a reference to the "bodas de oro" (50th anniversary) of this station.

9745 is one of the freq's for the Costa Rican relay of R Exterior de España. The tx's are located at Cariari de Pococí, not Cariari de Potosí as was said on a DX programme 30th July. In the same DX programme it was mentioned that 15674.6 R Copán Internacional, Honduras, in a Spanish language annc't had promised they would give away transistor receivers to the first five reporters. - Here's the background to that story: After phoning and faxing a report to Miami, I talked to Kiko Espinosa on the phone. (He's the announcer who was reading the promo). He had read my report and was surprised I had been able to pick up the back lobe of their signal, which is beamed to the N.E. They had received other reports, too, he said, even one referring to the open carrier of the stn (but apparently no one, except mine, referring to their offer). However, he didn't know if they would give out any radios, as the offer had been made without Jeff White's knowing it. --- One month after reporting I have yet to see if the promise is more than pure rhetoric.

And local people there said me the owner of Radio Colonial moved to Rioja at that time. The second time I visited again Nueva Cajamarca in Feb. 1987, at that time except of Radio Nuevo Cajamarca, any radio station did not exist there. So after 9 years of silence, the ex-transmitter of Radio Colonial was repaired, and has reactivated again since June 1993 by new station in same location. The station name "Radio La Voz de Alto Mayo" derives from "Rfo Alto Mayo", as you know, other outlet from Nueva Cajamarca, Radio Ondas del Mayo (now the station identifies itself as "Radio Ondas del Río Mayo") also derives from the same river. Two years ago, a radio station in Rioja had also been called itself as "Radio Alto Mayo"; now is identified as "Estación Laser". So "Alto Mayo" river is very famous and is so big in Departamento de San Martín. According to the station announcement, the nominal frequency is "6130kHz 49mb", however the outlet is heard on 6137.4kHz. H. That's all in this moment. More information about Nueva Cajamarca. Nueva Cajamarca was established on 29/06/75, as a "comunidad" (community) in the distrito de Yurayacu, Provincia de Rioja, Departamento de San Martín. The new community has been inhabited by colonists from the highlands (mostly from Departamento de Cajamarca), so they called it as Nueva Cajamarca (New Cajamarca). In November 1985 (exact date is unknown), the Peruvian government recognized Nueva Cajamarca as a new district in Departamento de San Martín. The tiny town has been developed along "Carretera Marginal", so "Carretera Marginal" is the main street for local peoples, and is called "Av. Cajamarca" by them. Thanks to trading activities between coast and lowland, as Nueva Cajamarca lies "Carretera Marginal", the village has expanded into a commercial district, with a friendly population of some 5,000 inhabitants today. When I visited there in 1987, there were three basic hotels which charged under a dollar per person. I saw many commercial stores along Av. Cajamarca where other two radio-stations are located. From Nueva Cajamarca, pick-up trucks leave frequently for Rioja on the improved road. The fare was 60c for the one-hour trip. Here you have to wait for vehicles to Pedro Ruiz/Bagua to continue the long journey for coast area.
