* 4779.7 R Oriental, Tena, Ecuador, new stn heard from 1000 until approx 2330. I don't know when they close down as the signal then gets drowned in the noise. Much rock music on this stn. Listed on MW 1360 kHz only in the WRTH, with SW as F. Pl. The SW freq is announced as 4780 kHz.

* H4798v Armonías de Risaralda, Risaralda (Caldas), Colombia, on new freq 18/9, 2135 "Tardes de fiesta con JJ".

* 4903.9 R La Palabra has verified!! Stn Mgr Yosu Arketa - probably a Basque, judging from his name - was stunned that this "micro-station" could be heard so far away. - Well, he doesn't know yet that the signal has made it as far as to Finland... The address is c/o Parroquia de Santa Ana, Santa Ana de Yacuma (Beni), Bolivia. (I thought the stn was off the air, as I couldn't hear it as clearly as before, but it isn't. It's just that they must have reduced the power to something like 0.1 kW or less). R San Ignacio, 4901.0, is active in the morning only, heard s/on 1045.

* 4950 R Bahá'i, Otavalo, Ecuador, apparently w/a new or an improved tx, as signal is very good from 1100-1600. Not audible on Sundays, nor at night.

* 6095.1 R Nacional del Perú, probably Lima, w/ annc'ts such as "R Nal del Perú, emisora dedicada a rescatar y difundir los valores de nuestro pueblo". Power is in the range of 10 kW as the signal is quite steady. Is active in the morning and at night.

* 6815.6 R Universo, Saposoa, Perú "en los 6800 kHz, banda internacional de los 40 metros" with "programación de prueba" as usual on Sunday nights, 27/9, at 0115. Fax QRM. -- Logged from this new QTH for the first time on 14/3 when the address was given as Av. Lima 307, Saposoa (San Martín).

Dominican Republic R Barahona-4930 heard at 10.26 on 26/10. Many mentions of Dominican Republic but no ID. Terrible hum dominates their modulation, but signal is strong. /HJ

Perú 4860.04 Radio Lider. I first heard this one on October 22:nd, but I did not hear an ID until the 26:th. Heard only in the mornings as early as 09.25. I still have not caught them signing on yet. Both news and campo music programmes heard between 10.00 and 10.30 as well as multiple ID:s as above. I can find no listing, past or present, of a Radio Lider on this frequency - doesn't seem to be Radio Lider in Cajamarca, 5335v. I did hear the station give giving greetings to Quillabamba one morning. Additionally there is a Radio Lider in Cusco on 1100 kHz, so there may be a connection there. /HJ

5015.96 Radio Hispana. I had been hearing this as a UNID in the mornings around 10.00, when I got a tip from TIN that this station is on this new frequency. I still have not heard an ID after many mornings of listening. I hear continuous campo music with canned time checks over the music. This canned time checks seemed to be used by other OA:s I have heard such as R Libertad. I have heard the above station as early as 09.30, but sign on (which I have not caught yet) has been even after 10.00 such as 28/10. /HJ

6095.02 R Nacional del Perú noted here around 03.00.
Media Network 4/11 via /CB

6200.6 LV de Huamanga heard 09.50, 27/10. ID by a man as I tuned in. Nothing but a het in the evenings. /HJ

COLOMBIA. In addition to their 3rd and 4th harmonics, I have now logged the 2nd harmonic of the pirate at Risaralda (Caldas), called Armonías de Risaralda, 17/10 at 2330, on 3242.2. The fundamental, announced as 1620, is inaudible in Bogotá.

Sonoradio 1520 AM, at Viterbo, also in Caldas, has been heard by the end of August on 4561 approx., and on 27/8 also on 6081.3. The harmonics are now gone.

On something like 4900, or rather 4899-4906v, also end of Aug., I noted a stn calling itself Su Frecuencia Musical AM. From the ads I conclude that the location is Quimbaya (Quindío). On 28/8 the stn signed off at 0040 with the NA after narrating the inauguration of a sports pavilion at Barrio La Esperanza.

The best time for Colombian harmonics seems to be between 2130 and 2330 and 1000-1100. The three aforementioned stns are best received in the AM mode, the signal usually being blurred and distorted. (If anyone thinks these pirates are an easy pick, he's welcome to come and try for himself).

La V del Río Arauca, 4895, is producing some horrible spurs + - 50 kHz for some time now. Strong spurs are also noted from La V de Yopal, 5050, on 4968.6 and 5129.7. Finally, Ondas del Meta, 4885, for a few days produced spurs on 4900.

A local harmonic in Bogotá, not too strong, is R Musical, 4x1280 or, more precisely, 5119.8.

The Armed Forces are running a number of low power stns in areas haunted by guerrilla. The net is called La V de los Heroes. In Caucasia, Antioquia, I visited one of these stns, located within the premises of the 29th Infantry Battalion "Rifles". It's called Brisas del Palmar, and is on 1520 with 0.3 kW. According to the civilian manager Jorge Zea, the stn has been on the air for some 6 years now, which would mean that the Bogotá stn Ecos del Palmar, on the same frequency, may have "borrowed" the slogan. A new stn was identified on 8/10, heard only once before, on 19/8: R San Andrés de Llapa, located at Llapa, which is a "distrito" in San Miguel province, Cajamarca department. The freq has not changed since August, remaining quite stable on 4254.5. The s/on is at approx. 2350 with the NA and - yes, you guessed it! - "El cóndor pasa". Then into "Anochecer campesino", which is a rather predictable prgr title. The signal is weak and sometimes harrassed by CW.

(In the Andean countries the word "campesino" is a euphemism for "indio". The latter word is as unpalatable to the local population as the word "negro" is to American black people).

Ecos del Atrato, 5020, has been active for more than a month, while Ondas del Darién, 6085, is off the air.

VENEZUELA. Radio Occidente, Tovar, listed on MW 1100, has surprisingly reappeared on 9750, after several years of absence. First noted on 13/10 around noon, local time, with rlg. and secular prgr. Carted ID includes - per usual Venezuelan practice - all licensed freq's, thus not only YVOS 9750, but also YVTC 3225, which I believe is inactive. 9750 seems to be on all day, although I can't pick it up thru the QRM after darkness.
