

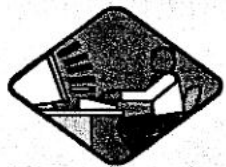

Kanske bättrar det sig med signaler och DX-lusten ute i stugorna nu när höstmörkret så sakta smyger sig på oss.

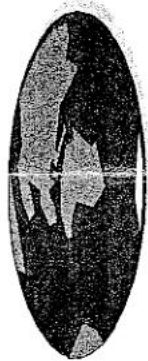

[**ANTARCTICA**] Sent to NU E-mailers on July 29 as NU 1383, Supp. A: 15476, LRA36, R. Nacional Arcangel San Gabriel, Base Esperanza, hrd July 25, SP s/on at 1800 with NA, ID by woman anncr as "transmite LRA36, R. Nacional Arcangel San Gabriel, ubicada en la Base Esperanza en el extremo norte de la península antártica o tierra de San Martín . . ." Prgm of talking about Villa General Belgrano, folk mx, full ID at 1851. At 1921 a prgm, "Variedades Internacionales," ID again at 1922 as "Desde la región geográfica más bella del mundo, donde imponen los vientos fríos más extremos, esta transmitiendo LRA36, Radio Nacional Arcangel San Gabriel, República Argentina, ubicada en la Base Esperanza en el extremo norte de la península antártica o tierra de San Martín, a los 63 grados 24 minutos de latitud sur, y a los 56 grados 59 minutos de longitud oeste del meridiano de Greenwich . . ." At 1941, s/off anmt with the military melody "Aurora." The stn broadcasts Mon-Fri at 1800-2000v, Phillips 1 kw. xmtr. SINPO 33443. (Barrera-Argentina)

[**BENIN**] 7210.2, ORTB, Cotonou, Aug 3 at 2205, back on this freq after an absence of several weeks; highlife numbers and occasional brief comments by seductive-sounding woman and unsexy-sounding man. Fine signal and usual crisp audio. Also nice to have Abidjan back on 7215 as well. (Hill-MA)

[**CHINA**] 15445, Easy FM, 1145-1200--no sign of them on July 31. (JB)

[**GUYANA**] 3290, Voice of Guyana, 0103-0113 on Aug 3, death anmts with person's name, surviving relatives and the repeated phrase, "also known as," read after the person's name. "The Rev. Charles Dowd, here is a message for you: Your brother is staying . . . and is awaiting your arrival . . . Calling Winston . . . here is a message for you: Please collect your sister . . . she will be arriving by steamer." And at 0116: "If you want help, give your phone number . . . public employee liability telephone number 876-42 . . ." Exc signal at times. (Wilkner-FL)

[**PERU**] 3280.6, Estacion Wari, Ayacucho, Aug 3 at 1135-1206, SINPO 22222, folkloric mx, ID as "De esta manera Estacion Wari, presento . . ." Ad for El Juzgado de Ayacucho, and the Savings and Credit Cooperativa de Huamanga. Another ID, "Ud. escucha Estacion Wari," and prgm "La Voz del Cooperativismo, de 7.30 a 8 de la mañana a través de la mejor estación regional Estacion Wari." Needed USB. (Arrunategui-Peru, Chasqui DX)

6420.3, R. Mi Frontera, Aug 2, 0035-0120, SINPO 22222, ID: "Y continuamos adelante con nuestra música en R. Mi Frontera." Mx, another ID: "Son las 7 y 55 de la noche en R. Mi Frontera." Pasillos, saludos to amigos en Cochalan, San Ignacio, San Pedro, ID (amid CW QRM) again as "Esta es Mi Frontera," and "A través de R. Mi Frontera, la voz de la Peruanidad . . . manténgase en sintonía de R. Mi Frontera, un saludo a nuestros amigos de San Francisco." Also "R. Mi Frontera, transmitiendo desde el distrito de [couldn't get, spoke too quickly] . . . Región Nor Oriental, transmite en la banda internacional de onda corta de los 49 metros . . . R. Mi Frontera . . ." Mx, ID again: "A todos esos amigos que nos escuchan a todo volumen, R. Mi Frontera . . ." (Arrunategui-Peru, Chasqui DX)

[**RUSSIA**] 9880, R/S Kala Alturaya, July 27 at *1500, beginning Sat. afternoon b/c with opening anmts and nx in RS, SINFO 43433. At 1528, also found on //7325, where they had not been when checked shortly after 1500.

(Sandte-Germany, Cumbre) What exactly is this one? RS stn hrd s/on at 1500 on Aug 3 after tone run-up, opening with RM IS. (JB)

[**ZANZIBAR**] 11734.12, RTZ, July 26 at 1731-1754, vernac., tribal mx with drums, strong het, SINPO 22342. (Barrera-ARG)

The HIGH FREQUENCY SPECTRUM STUDY #1, portraying detailed monitoring observations made in Victoria, Australia, during June 1996, for SW commercial b/cs between 0000 and 0400 UTC, on freqs 4750-7490 kHz, is now available. Some 160 entries are included, giving b/cing organizations, xmtr sites, and languages. The study period was chosen to coincide with the Australian mid-winter solstice period, from 10 am until 2 pm local time, at the minimum point in Solar Cycle 22, for Z96. The study is accompanied by descriptive material outlining propagation mechanisms, which discusses xmsn into eastern Australia at local noon, on 6 MHz, from Europe, Africa, the Americas, and the Middle East. Comparisons are made with reception during the Australian mid-winter made during the last solar maximum. Printed form only, 14 A4 pages.
