NU 1439, August 31, 1997

HONDURAS. 4959.0, HRET, 0104-0205* Aug 26, checking up on Bob Wilkner's discovery (see NU 1438). Tune-in to definite Miskito lang man, reggae-ish and gospel vocals in SP, accented SP man at 0140: "HRET . . . 4960 kc/s . . . Honduras . . ." more mx. 0203 clear "HRET" ID by man with a bit of fill mx, off 0205 without NA or fanfare. However, not certain if what I'm hearing is the same stn RLW, JB et al. are hearing, since the fqy was 4959 solid, no fading, and definite SP/Miskito lingo, along with no EG. (Krueger-FL) Definitely the same. JB.


LAOS. 4691, tent. Lao Natl Radio, Houa Phan, 1054 Aug 24, very weak, but did catch bits of mx. Gone at 1111 recheck. This may very well be possible on ECNA on a good morning. Should be possible in the evening, as well as in December if 0000 sked holds. (Valko-PA)

MALAYSIA. 7295, RTM Radio 4, Kuala Lumpur, 1045 Aug 26-29. Local reggae, Euro-dance, No Doubt selection, pop oldies, ads. EG female DJ chatter incl. "Radio 4" IDs, short and long pip at 1100, ID, nx. Signal strong, but chronically watery-sounding. (Novello-NC)

MALDIVES. Per stn personnel, Voice of Maldives is still planning to return to SW, but not until the middle of next year, with Australian aid. The fqy will most likely be in the 25 mb, 0600-0000 local time. (Vaghjee-Mauritius)

MEXICO. 6105, the sporadically active Tus Panteras, Merida, was back Aug 28 at 1213 with nx, Mexican clue-words such as "pesos," "Secretaria," and finally at 1225, "aqui en Merida," tho no ID hrld. Had been listed as off the air in Jeff White's early-August summary via Cumbre. Somewhat undermodulated, but right on fqy, bad slop from the 6110 battleground. Afterwards, rcvd E-mail from Hector Garcia in Mexico that he had also been hearing 6105, but IDs as Candela FM; and that Julian Santiago found out from stn that the 810 outlet relayed on SW is no longer Tus Panteras but R. Formula Merida (Hauser-OK, GH's SW/DX Rpt) 6185, R. Educacion now says they plan to upgrade to 10 kw, not 50 kw. (Hector Garcia, WoR) forts. på nästa sida.

URUGUAY. 9620, SODRE, CXA6 is currently inactive, but could resume xmsn in a day or two. Technicians are working on the xmtr to set the output fqy to the nominal 9620--it had been operating on 9621.3-9621.5. They found it a bit difficult to adjust the fqy with the currently-used crystal, so they plan to get another. As previously rptd, xmtr power is around 300 watts. The dipole they are using is facing to the south. (Nigro-Uruguay, per Francisco Escobar at xmtr site)

UZBEKISTAN. 4850. Uzbek Radio, 0058-0102 Aug 25, Asian mx, orch. IS played twice to 0100 presumed nx by man, possibly in RS. Fairly good and alone on channel; no sign of AIR-Kohima. (Clark-ONT)

VIETNAM. 6704.1, Lao Cai, 1048-1054 Aug 24, just tribal choral mx. 5595.1v was much weaker, so couldn't tell if // This channel was distorted. 5924.58 was doing well, but fading at 1106 recheck. (Valko-PA)

ZAMBIA. 3330.0, R. Christian Voice, 0447 Aug 30 at good levels on USB which is the unmodulated sideband of CHU. Local mx with male ancr in lang. (Rippel-VA)

COMMENTS & OTHER INFO

THE NEW Drake R8B RX: The main change over the R8A is the addition of a sideband selectable synchronous detector. Drake has also upgraded the electronics to accomodate a total of 1,000 memory channels, and the scan speed has also been increased. They have also done some manufacturing "clean up" on the boards such that a small amount of digital noise appearing only on higher fqys has been corrected. The rx has been slated for release October 1 at a price of \$1199. Drake said to watch their WWW site for release date annmts: <http://www.rldrake.com/> (Rippel-VA)
