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

Perseus and Excalibur side by side

Those interested in a somewhat carefully made comparison of both receivers of typical and very different DX situations (regarding signal strength, modulation, interference ...) may drop an ear to some screencasts at:

All examples were made with each receiver tuned to it's best reception, using the audio output by Roland's Cakewalk loudspeaker, and Sennheiser's HD465 headphones, both providing a very rich audio. Unlike just MP3s, screencasts provide a full documentation of the reception, including the positions of all controls.

With You Tube, upload, hosting and download is made very easy, and without 3rd party software, which one has to govern to get the best results of. (Take AGC OFF for Perseus, e.g.) Directing the screencasts maybe a rather time-consuming job, even with some experience in both listening and screencast software (here: BB FlashBack pro, look at: <http://www.bbsoftware.co.uk/bbflashback/home.aspx>). To be quite honest, I needed the better part of more than three days to make those Excalibur/Perseus screencasts. In return, people get a ready-to-use and quick overlook within minutes on the general (!) performance of both receivers - by looking virtually over ones shoulder.

There are some traps with this kind of comparison, as we had discussed in the past. They can be reduced even further, but can't be avoided to a specific degree, what viewers should always take into account.

Time permitting, I will compare the trio of SDR-IP, Excalibur, and Perseus by this method in the future.

My personal finding will be published - alas, in German - in the magazine "Radio Kurier" of

ADDX. It's Germany's biggest monthly for SWLs, and should appear in their August's issue. The July issue carries MEDAV's/SSB's LAN receiver as cover story.

Hi folks, Further to my announcement to Glenn Hauser's DX Listening Digest Yahoo Group last month re Radio Symban returning to SW: I can confirm that **Radio Symban is now back on air 2368.5 kHz** from its third SW transmitter site in Sydney's SW (Leppington). Noting the station on air today June 26, 2010 at 0125 UT. I'm unsure of the exact date this station came to air, but it is within the last 6 or 7 days. CENTRAL AFRICAN REP. 7220 R.Centrafrique, Bimbo, 1022-1315, 03 Jul'10, Vernacular, folk music, ..., French, news at 1300 when their signal was already v. poor; 25432. They were noted on at 1915. (Carlos Gonçalves - POR)

CENTRAL AFRICAN REPUBLIC. 5035.6, Radio ICDI, 1731, presumed, French, talk by a man, clear mentions of "Centrafricaine." Under heavy CODAR QRM. 26 June. (David Sharp, NSW Australia: dxldyg via WORLD OF RADIO 1520, DX LISTENING DIGEST)

CENTRAL AFRICAN REPUBLIC. 7220, Radio Centrafrique, 1828, French, really pleased to hear this one, and at a good level (averaging S9+30dB), with talk by a man (news or similar) with several references to "Bangui." First time heard, after several days of trying. 5035 (presumed R. ICDI) also in, but threshold. 6 July (David Sharp, NSW Australia: dxldyg via WORLD OF RADIO 1520, DX LISTENING DIGEST)

David, Nice logs. Radio ICDI is supposed to be on 6030 and new 3390, with R. Centrafrique on 5035v and 7220. If you hear both 5 and 7 at same time, can you tell if they are //? 73, (Glenn Hauser, ibid.)

Hi Glenn (and everyone), Cannot say whether 7220 and 5035v were in //. While 7220 was absolutely booming-in, 5035v was not much more than a carrier. I know there seems to be some confusion as to whether ICDI is on 5035 or if it's a second frequency for Radio Centrafrique. My initial question is, "Why have both transmitters on at the same time?" Because 7220 is obviously getting great coverage (though perhaps the higher freq skips over part of the country). It'll take a very good opening to get audio here on 5035v but will try again over the weekend and see if it's //. 73s (David Sharp, NSW Australia, ibid.)

David, My guess would be that R. Centrafrique got their old main transmitter running again on 7220; and meanwhile are also using the 1 kW HCJB had to give them, because it's there. And of course might fill in some skipzone gap (Glenn, ibid.)

Hi Glenn, It's quite possible R. Centrafrique is using 5035v "because it's there." And in all probability, I'd have to agree, it's them. If I can't confirm the //, hopefully someone closer-in can hear both (David Sharp, ibid.)

Report included a 7 min recording referred to in the e-mail and a screen shot of the Perseus spectrum during reception at the same time period on 6/30. I won't be holding my breath on the QSL card, Hi! These days, an e-mail QSL is pretty much all you can count on. E-mail rcvd read as follows (answers the location question but not the station's power for which I will query Jobby):

Dear Bruce,

Greetings from Tabubil in the Star Mountains of the Western Province of Papua New Guinea.

Thank you for your email which I received yesterday. I must apologise as I didn't get around to replying most of my emails yesterday but am going through them today.

I confirm that you were listening to Radio Fly. We are an FM radio station but only expanded into shortwave about a month ago. 5960 kHz & 3915 kHz.

What you were listening to was the service announcements by Beri Pius. She is a journalist who does mainly news but tries a bit of broadcasting or Disc Jockeying as well. She usually does the Friday & Saturday nights as we are also short staffed. Thanks for your detailed report which I will forward to our technical personnel.

Unfortunately we haven't designed a QSL card yet. Once we do, we will send you one.

Until then, I thank you for your report.
