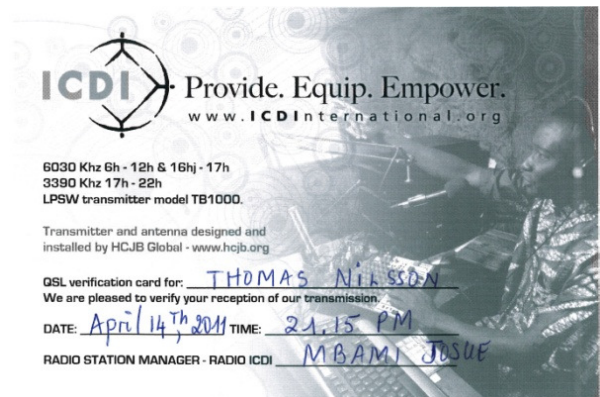

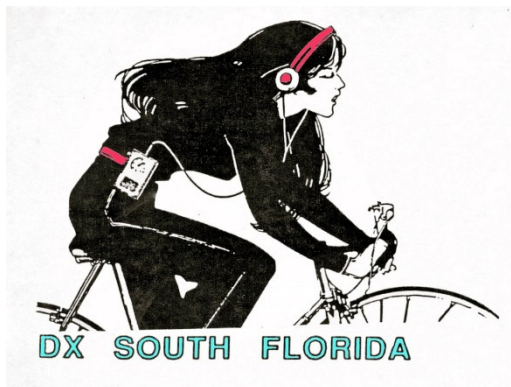

Radio and television in Yemen (From Wikipedia, the free encyclopedia)

Broadcasting began in Yemen in the 1940s when it was still divided into South by the British and North by Imami ruling system. After the unity of Yemen in 1990, Yemeni government reformed its corporations and founded some additional radio channels which can broadcast locally. However it drew back after 1994 due to destroyed infrastructures by the civil war. In 1995 it commenced its first TV broadcasting abroad and since then there has been some gradual increase in its radio and television channels most of which belong to the government.

Southern Yemen

British army established a small radio station at Ra's Bradly in the Tawahi district of Aden in 1940. It was mainly to give military news about the Second World War, together with information about precautions against air raids. Aden Radio was then established on 7 August 1954. Al-Mukalla radio was established in 1967, soon after the residence of Southern Yemen and Sayun radio in 1973. Television service was established in 1963 in monochrome whereas colour transmission started in the South on 8 March 1981.

Northern Yemen

Sana'a Radio was established in January 1946 but closed after two years, resuming in 1955. In 1963 another local radio station in Ta'iz was established, and Al-Hodeida in 1969. TV channel service began broadcasting in 1975 in monochrome and colour transmission started in the north in 1979.

Unity

Yemen was united in 1990 leading to merging of southern and northern authorities and corporations. Al-Mukalla radio channel was reformed, Al-Hodeida was also improved. Haja radio was established later in 2004, Sada and Ibb radio stations in 2007. On the other hand, Yemen TV channels joined space TV channels on Arabsat, Nilesat and some other satellites the years after 1995.

ECUADOR: INOCAR, 1510 has been logged also in Finland during the last few years, don't know what the ID has been. It has had time signal in the background. Tried to check 3810 kHz from some April 2011 files, but no trace of it. To get radio information from Middle Eastern & African countries the Internet doesn't help much. And mostly all kinds of info requests, be they email or traditional letters remain totally unanswered. I suppose for Latin America there is already too much information these days. Difficult to know what is reliable and up to date.

MAURETANIA: Mauritania has been missing from 4845 for months, altho there is one recent report of it I would like confirmed. If anyone does hear it // 783, please report. The other IGIM (abbr. for the Arabic ID) SW frequency, 7245 has been in use instead, 24h during Ramadan, but now you never know whether it will be on before 0500 or not on after 0600, so check both it and 4845. Estranha esta transmissão, não há nada listado nos órgãos oficiais e nenhuma menção em qualquer lugar. Vamos ver o que acontece. grande abraço. Samuel

Lite om magnetiska ekvatorn

Det är också så att stationerna strax omkring (ovanför och nedanför magnetiska ekvatorn som går från Lima i en RÖRLIG och krokig väg upp till Belém) ställer till det för sådana som lyssnar på dem från positioner på motsatt sida.

Slutsatsen borde därför bli att denna, liksom Xapuri, ligger norr om magnetiska ekvatorn och därmed blir mer eller mindre ohörbar i södra/sydöstra Brasilien.

Min egen erfarenhet från Colombia, Ecuador och Peru visar på samma sak, fast från motsatt vinkel. Det var bara ett par gånger om året jag kunde lyssna på stationer som låg söder om magnetiska ekvatorn, medan stationer norr om den alltid hördes relativt bra. Ta fram en karta och studera:

Villa Montes 4593 mycket sällsynt. Perla del Acre 4600 jättevanlig och stark. Nordliga bolivianer, Cobija, Riberalta, Guayaramerin gick vanligtvis bra, La Paz också, medan södra Bolivia, Sucre, Santa Cruz, Potosí var jobbiga.

Argentina och Brasilien söder om magnetiska ekvatorn jättesvårt. 870 LRA hördes bara en gång vad jag kan minnas. Rio och São Paulo mycket svårt. (Dario Monferini rapporterar god mottagning av brassar i södra Peru. Tro det! Han befann sig ju då söder om magnetiska ekvatorn). Brassarna i Amazonas på 60 och 90 m var lätta att logga och höra.

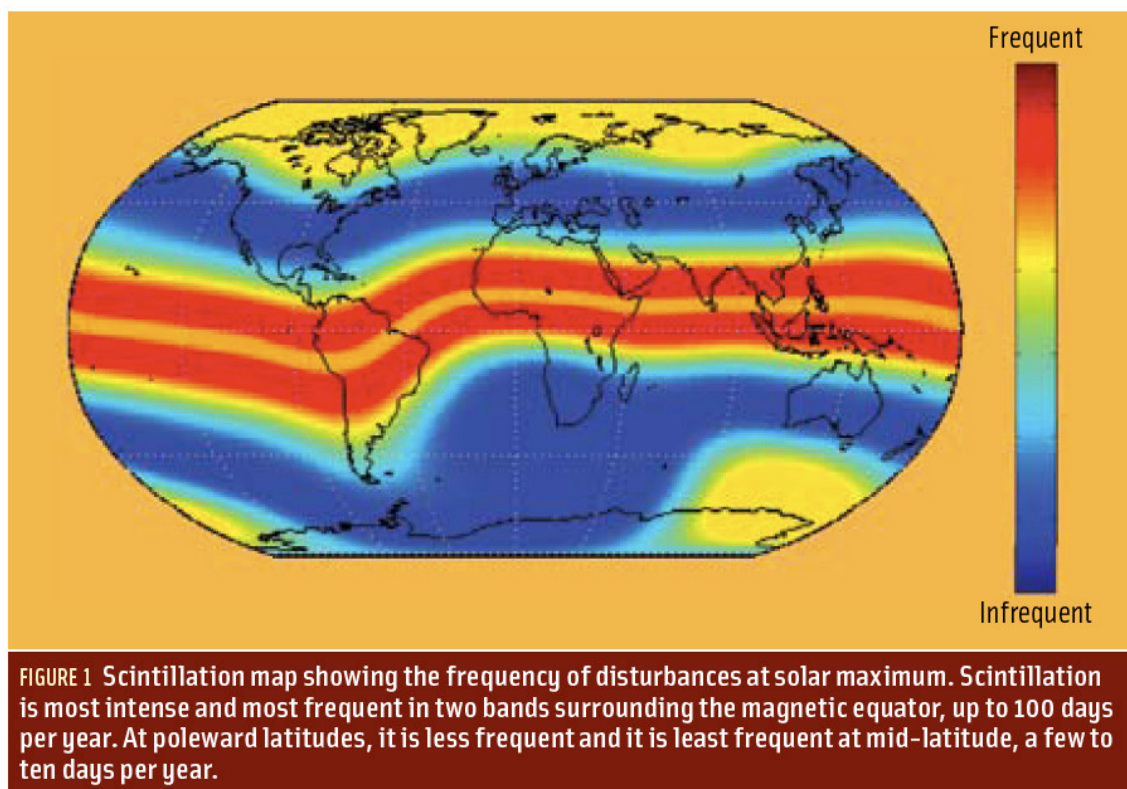
6160 Malargüe (norra Argentina) bara ett par gånger i juni.

Det finns en stor forskningsstation med hundratals antenner intill Lima som ligger just på den magnetiska ekvatorn. Jag tror jag har en scannad bild på en annan dator som jag skulle kunna skicka över.

Det fanns tidigare en hel del kartor och grejer om magnetiska ekvatorn på nätet, men jag har inte kollat på senare år.

Flera led-lampor har fått försäljningsförbud

Att lågenergi lampor och även LED-lampor kan störa ordentligt har jag själv egen erfarenhet av. Se [artikel om störande LED](#) som jag skrev redan 2009. Nu har i alla fall Elsäkerhetsverket beslutat om försäljningsförbud för ett antal fabrikat. Anledningen är att deras styrelektronik inte håller måttet. De värsta lamporna hade uppmätta störnivåer som låg betydligt högre än 50 dB över maximala gränsvärdet. Det rapporteras i nr 38 av tidningen Ny Teknik. (SM2DCU, Ulf Åkesson, www.fura.se/)

Led-lampor stör elnätet Av: [Charlotta von Schultz](#) Publicerad 21 september 2011

Flera led-lampor har fått försäljningsförbud på sistone. Orsak: de sprider störningar på elnätet.

Flera ledlampor har stoppats.

Energisnåla lysdiodslampor blir allt mer populära. Men deras styrelektronik håller inte alltid måttet.

Enbart i augusti stoppade Elsäkerhetsverket försäljningen av tre led-lampor som stör elnätet. Den värsta låg skyhögt över tillåtna nivåer, mer än 56 dB. Den näst sämsta finns i samma strykclass med störningar på 54,9 dB över gränsvärdet.

- Det är väldigt mycket. Lamporna är inte farliga för människor, men de kan störa andra elektriska apparater, säger Ulf Johansson, inspektör på Elsäkerhetsverket.

Störningarna kan orsaka irriterande brus i radion, flimrande bild på skärmen eller att funktion och livslängd hos elanslutna apparater påverkas. Kommunikation via elnätet kan också störas.

De förbjudna led-lamporna är CE-märkta, vilket innebär att importören eller tillverkaren garanterar att produkten håller sig inom EU:s gränsvärden. Men det gör de fallerande lamporna uppenbarligen inte.

Elsäkerhetsverket ser allvarligt på problemet, eftersom led-lampor väntas bli mycket vanliga nu när vanliga glödlampor fasas ut.

Därför har den svenska myndigheten tillsammans med sin belgiska motsvarighet tagit initiativ till en gemensam kampanj där flera EU-länder deltar.

Målet är att skanna av marknaden för att få en uppfattning om det behövs fler riktade insatser.

- Vi vill även få bort dåliga produkter från marknaden i tid, säger Ulf Johansson.

De senaste månaderna har myndigheterna kontrollerat närmare 130 lysdiodslampor.

I räden ingår bland annat lampor med GU10-sockel (spotlights) och E27-sockel (glödlampersättare). Stora, etablerade varumärken såväl som små, okända tillverkare granskas. Nu utvärderas kampanjen, resultaten presenteras senare i höst. (Tidningen Ny Teknik)
