Under festmiddagen delades det första stipendiet från Johan Berglunds minnesfond ut. Detta gick, mycket välförtjänt till den mångåriga kämpen och gotlänningen Björn Fransson.

Förbundets bronsplakett erhöll Alf Persson, dito i guld tillföll Bengt Dalhammar och SDXF:s avgående ordförande Owe Nordin.

SWB önskar alla pristagarna ett jätttestort grattis för dessa utmärkelser. Ni har verkligen gjort er förtjänta av denna uppmarksamhet. Det är dessutom trevligt att konstatera att alla är eller har varit medlemmar i SWB.

Det är också intressant att läsa i CON's reportage att det inte är alldeles lätt att få den nya DX-Aktuellt (före detta EA), i ett enhetligt utförande. De två första numren har kommit ut och det ena producerades i Sverige och det andra i Norge. Båda redaktionerna har satt sin egen prägel på utgåvorna. Om jag förstår det rätt, så lider man dessutom av samma svårigheter som för de flesta andra DX-publikationer, SWB inräknat, att hitta formen för innehållet. Det är inte heller lätt att mönstra redaktörer för de olika spalterna, de unga aktiva har så mycket annat för sig så man kan fråga sig vad som händer när åldern tar ut sin rätt för de inblandade där ett antal ligger långt över pensionsstrecket. /TN

Arne Nilsson: Stationen på 5014,7 hörs inte alls bra här. Men det gör ingenting annat heller just nu.

Så jag har passat på att få igång min AFEDRI igen. Den har inte varit på sedan några månader, faktiskt.

Jag kör med SDR-Radio v1.5 och plötsligt slutade det fungera. Felet visade sig vara det klassiska: Brandväggen!

Nu funkar det igen och då passade jag på att ladda ner SDR-Radio v2. Den känns ganska trevlig, bättre ljud än med v1.5. Dessutom kan man ställa Gain direkt från programmet vilket gör det mycket smidigare än med den gamla versionen.

Däremot finns ingen scheduler på den så att man kan ställa in tidsbestämda inspelningar! Hoppas ngt kommer så småningom.

Det är ändemot väldigt tyxt om Studio 1. Blev den inte vad man hoppades på (och betalade för!)? Vad jag vet har inte heller AHK dragit igång den. Jag kan ändemot väl tänka mig att betala en slant för SDR-Radio då den är klar. Den passar väldigt bra för AFEDRI och man ska ju också kunna köra Perseus med den. Har du testat?



Synd att ingen kan få koll på 5014. Det finns ID där men det är förbannat svårt att få fram nåt.

Har inte testat någon SDR-Radio variant på länge, blev inte riktigt vän med layouten på programmet. Tycker att Perseus gränssnitt är mycket mer användarvänligt. Jag kanske bär mig dumt åt, men får inngen snits på kurvorna och waterfall lägena så att man kan avläsa på ett bra sätt. Dessutom fattar jag inte de där banden som ligger över och under i displayen. Får nog gå en kurs.

Studio 1 har nog inte blivit vad man hoppats på. Förväntningarna var ju höga. Tror att deras gränssnitt är för krångligt. Det skall vara enkelt och intuitivt, vilket jag tycker att Perseus står för. /TN

Jag lyssnade igår men det gick inte att få fram begripligt ljud. - När jag först hörde stationen för flera dagar sedan var den mkt svag. Jag funderade då om det kunde vara den återstartade ICDI varför förfrågan gick till USA om frekvens etc. Ännu inget svar därifrån. Jag har vid ett tillfälle hört en fransktalande på 5035 (för 6 månader sedan) men ICDI kommer väl kanske på de gamla frekvenserna eftersom såväl antenner som slutsteg är anpassade. At 1259 talkshow with 1-855-79XX number keeps going a few seconds past 1300, and there may have been an ID including the letters ``BZ``, but too much QRM from BS. SRN News starts late. Next check 1329, the crosstalk is finally removed from 9980 leaving BS only; this no doubt correlates with someone arriving to work at WWCR and finally noticing the problem (Glenn Hauser, OK)

To record the full spectrum would require a top end PC, at least i7, and your next limitation will be storage bottlenecks followed by the storage capacity. A lot of ram will be needed to. Minimum spec is OK, but if you want to run anything else, or not have to strip down the OS to play with this 'toy/tool' you need to run a very good PC almost as expensive as the Winradio itself. I have an i5 gaming laptop with 8Gb ram and a proper top end GPU, that stutters if I run my G31DDC at the same time as some data mode decoders. I loose frame rate if I try to make a screen-grab video at the same time. Nice hardware, but you need even more top-end hardware to run it.

Hi Dennis, The G31DDC issues you are experiencing are all due to the software, I can run an Ettus N210 at 10MHz bandwidth without any issues on an i7 – 930 (second generation, 2.8GHz) and CPU is between 4% and 8%.

Supporting the new WR-G35DDCi would be a challenge but also very doable. Streaming IQ data to disk at 120 MB/s is not a big issue with SSD, one company I know just bought a special petabyte array using SSD.
