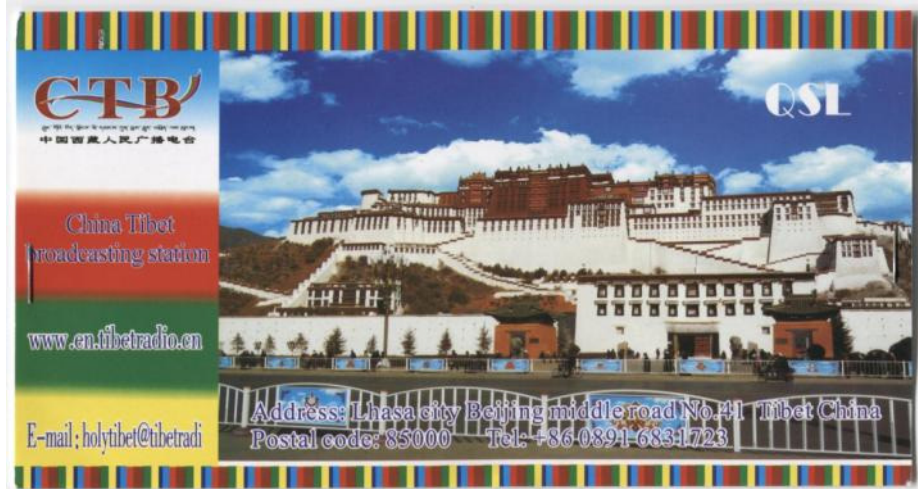

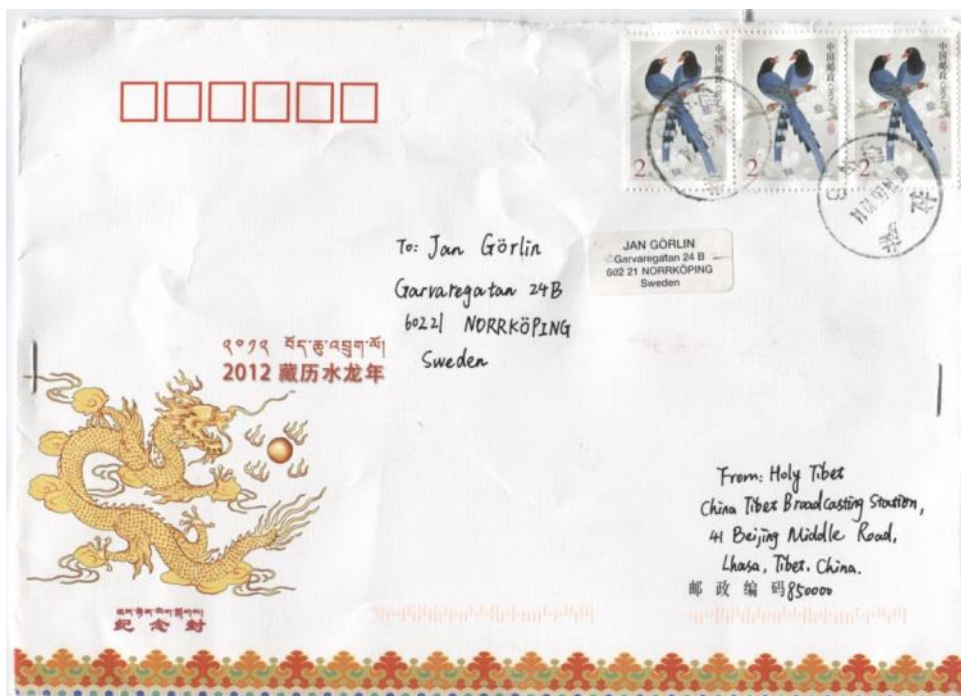

**Hans Östnell** (HR i Vardø): Sänder över ett litet bidrag från lyssnandet ute i Komagvær förra helgen, samt några dagar i början av veckan. Var där ute den 22-24 augusti och monterade upp mina bägge deltaloppar, och det visade sig att de fungerade alldeles förträffligt! Det blev mest MV-lyssning, men det var kul att höra Radio Nord Revival och att få Radio Gramox i loggen. Radio Nord Revival gick förresten som "skvalradio" i husvagnen hela lördagen den 23 augusti, medan jag "småfixade" ditt och datt på och kring antennerna. Signalen på 6065 hördes fenomenalt bra här uppe i nord!

Vad gäller mellanväg, så har höstsäsongen redan startat här uppe. Redan runt 17 UTC så hördes flera filippinska och thailändska stationer med riktigt goda styrkor, mängder med kineser förstås, men den stora "överraskningen" var att 5AN ABC Adelaide på 891 kHz loggades redan den 25 augusti kl 1825! "ABC-fanfar" och ABC-News kunde sedan avnjutas 18:30, innan stationen dök ner i bruset. Vet inte hur vanligt, eller ovanligt, det är att det loggas "aussies" här uppe så tidigt, men om inte annat så är det ett bevis på att mina looppar funkar som de skall, samt att Komagvær är ett mycket "tyst" QTH med bra takeoff mot Asien och Pacific. Det lovar gott!

Det har kommit in en del QSL, men det får vi ta nästa gång. Har fortfarande några IQ-inspelningar att granska innan det är dags att författa ett bidrag till kommande MV-Eko.

#### PIRATER

SDXF har ju accepterat piraterna, det finns en Piratspalt och QSL från pirater räknas i QSL-cupen. ARC har iakttagit en mer

avvisande hållning, begripligt genom att en del pirater inom området 1600-1700 kHz stör DX-stationer som intresserar MVDX-arna.

Men om vi tittar på för och emot, tycker jag mig kunna notera:

### **EMOT**

Sändningarna sker utan licens

De kan i vissa fall störa nyttotrafik då de inte har tilldelats frekvenser

Operatörerna betalar inga STIM-pengar och motsvarande för den musik de använder

### **FÖR**

Begreppet 'legal' eller 'illegal' kan diskuteras. I kraft av statligt bestämmande sänder åtskilliga länder på icke-auktorerade frekvenser med mycket hög effekt, inte så få använder också störsändare

Militära stationer sänder oberoende av någon frekvenstilldelning!

Piratradion utgörs av stationer av hobbykaraktär, ofta med låg effekt och med sporadiska sändningar, vilket gör dem till intressanta DX-fångster

Operatörerna är ofta mycket kunniga tekniskt och de har förmåga att i regel välja "rätt" frekvens, så att störningar av nyttotrafik sällan förekommer

Deras 'illegala' uppträdande innebär inget som helst samhällsproblem eller andra olägenheter

Ja, det var mina synpunkter. Faktum är att i dessa tider är för min del piraterna ett av de få positiva inslagen i hobbyn.

Fantasisfulla QSL-kort kommer med e-posten, emellanåt med motiv lite åt det gubbsjuka hållet, men vid 80 års ålder har jag inte mycket invändningar att komma med! 🤔

## **Fighting local noise**

**Lots of ferrites** available on eBay with different center hole sizes. Inexpensive in lots of 10 or 20. Most from China.

Using them liberally took my local noise down 3 S-units. Of course, requires a good radio like the Perseus or Drake to hear the improvement.

Also, helpful to put them on speaker wires.

FYI: twisted pair is the most noise resistant cable architecture.

Cut up old out of spec ethernet cables for speaker wire.

Don't remove/worry about unused wires in cut up cable, or ground them if you want to be fastidious.

Of course, where ohmage is important (Antenna feed) you cannot use twisted pair.

-----  
Core material is very important when choosing a noise suppression method. A core may have high impedance at low frequencies, but low impedance at higher frequencies, and vice versa.
