Carlos Gonçalves. Glenn, Thomas, My apologies to both of you as I should have prepared the report "ages" ago, but since I didn't, I decided to include the 26-28JUL observations too. Needless to say I won't feel surprised, if this material is considered "too old" for use. The 60 m band was dreadful during our week long stay at the SW coast place, "CGS" in my logsheets, with too much static and few stations audible. Perhaps not so, if I kept DXing well beyond midnight local time.

Ullmar Qwick via NORDX: Livets labyrinter och märkliga sammanträffanden.

I Färjestaden på Öland bor en nu 80-årig man, Sadulla Zendeli, känd som "Daja" (det albanska ordet för morbror). Han har varit skolbibliotekarie, pizzeriägare och bokförläggare. På hans meritlista finns en rad ordböcker, svensk-albanska och albansk-svenska. "Daja" föddes i Gostivar i Makedonien i en albansk familj, men han tvangs att av politiska skäl bege sig till Sverige redan 1966.

I Tirana finns en trogen vän till Sverige, läraren Viron Kona som besökt vårt land flera gånger och givit ut flera böcker med svenska motiv. Nu kom hans biografi över vännerne Sadulla Zendeli, och Kona har på ett beundransvärt sätt fått fram många märkliga omständigheter och fakta.

Varför jag skriver om den här saken i NORDX beror på något mycket märkligt. Kona har kommit på att han har två vänner i Sverige, som på olika sätt är förbundna med Radio Kukësi. Och vi får då veta varför Sadulla Zendeli kallas just "Daja". Sedan Radio Kukësi startat 1959 blev stationen omtyckt av albanerna utanför landets gränser. Men den jugoslaviska regimen tolererade inga kontakter mellan dessa albaner och staten Albanien, och man försökte också stoppa deras lyssnande på albansk radio. Bland Zendelis vänner bland albanerna i norra Makedonien var det många som hörde på stationen i Kukësi, men då man pratade om den använde man täckspråk: "Har du hört något nytt från Daja? Vad sa Daja igår kväll?" o.s.v. Ordet Daja betydde alltså Radio Kukësi. Det fanns nämligen risk att någon av UDB:s - jugoslaviska säkerhetstjänstens - agenter skulle höra om man pratade om Radio Kukësi. En annan albano i Sverige har berättat att i Kosovo blev det fängelsestraff för den som ertappades med att ha lyssnat på Radio Kukësi.

Samtidigt, berättar Viron Kona, satt Ullmar Qwick i Sverige och hörde (helt ofarligt) på den

lilla albanska lokala radiostationen. Därmed befästes hans intresse för Albanien och dess folkmusik....

Trots många års kontakter med "Daja" har jag inte tidigare fått veta, hur han fick sitt smeknamn. Nu kan jag berätta för honom att en hel rad svenskar med radio som hobby av och till lyssnade på Radio Kukësi. Jag har just skrivit till deras speaker Aida och berättat om boken. Aida har tidigare i sommar varje veckohelg läst kapitel ur albanska utgåvan av min bok "Mera hjältemod än vete" om Albaniens 1900-talshistoria.

Ja, mina vänner, det finns mycket som ryms inom vår hobby. Ibland svämmar det över sina bräddar. Och även om mycket av detta idag är vackra minnen kan vi säga att radio har varit och är ett fantastiskt medium.

I had not heard them recently and believed they were off the air, so was a surprise to first tune in 1248-1300 to hear their unique indigenous music/singing; 1331-1347 monologue; 1347-1401 more indigenous music/singing; by 1422 heard phone conversations; still on the air when tuned out at 1430. Some mixing with PBS Yunnan (China), in Vietnamese and Chinese, but most of the time BBS was stronger. The last I knew BBS signed off about 1300, so they really were on an extended schedule today.			

			Would be wonderful if this was a new schedule for them? 





GHANA. Ghana Broadcasting Corporation marks 80th anniversary

The Ghana Broadcasting Corporation (GBC) on Friday celebrated its 80th anniversary, taking its listeners and its website visitors through the evolution of the station. On Friday, various programmes were done including one in Hausa language, where the National Chief Imam, Sheik Osman Nuhu Sharabutu, offered Muslim prayers for the GBC. The Director General of GBC, Major (Retired) Albert Don Chebe, praised past directors and staff for bringing the station this far and pledged that the current generation of broadcasters would work hard to improve on set standards.

GBC is the first radio station to be established in Ghana in 1953 by Sir Arnold Hudson, then Governor of the Gold Coast which is known today as Ghana.

He was assisted by F. A. W. Byron, a British Radio Engineer, and transmission was through a rediffusion box.

GBC is seen by many Ghanaians as the pace-setter when it comes to broadcasting, training prominent many Ghanaian news readers.

Dear friends, the new Perseus software version I planned to make available at the end of 2014 is almost ready.

I apologize for the delay. At the beginning of the year I had some problems that kept me far away from the concentration I needed to complete the development I promised up to few time ago.

Anyway, the playback version of the Perseus V will be available probably by mid August. It will serve as a full demonstration of the new software release so that everyone could decide if it will be worth buying the full version which I will make available soon later.

In this new version, besides the resizable GUI, I've changed a lot of things. I've redesigned part of the DSP chain in order to get a greater performance, and changed also a lot on the tuning methods in order to make the GUI more comfortable.

Along with the playback version I will try to publish a starting guide so that everyone could better understand the differences with the previous software revisions.

For what concerns the real-time version I need to understand which kind of problems are still experienced under Windows 7 and here comes your feedbacks. For the development I'm using two systems, a 64-bit W7 professional o.s. and a 32 bit system. I've no hardware initialization problems in both cases. The Perseus WinUsb drivers are still unsigned but get installed on the 64-bit system provided that the user accept to install them when the system requires to do it.

I will not reply to your feedbacks but they would help me anyway to better understand what actions should be taken to solve the most common issues concerning the hardware installation. So please don't hesitate.

What I can say you more? The new software version looks pretty good and I'm quite satisfied of the job I've done.
I think you will appreciate it soon as well.

I'm very pleased to report that after depending on the FRG-7 as main receiver for many years, I have acquired a top-of-the-line unit, the JRC NRD-545. This came quite unexpectedly as a gift from Jim Ronda, an eminent academic who has much weightier matters on his mind, but still enjoys some DXing on another receiver. For example:

Jim was also instrumental in getting the superb Gilcrease Museum (which we also revisited) transferred from the City of Tulsa to the University of Tulsa, and remains on the museum board.

For now the NRD-545 is merely connected to my existing antenna, a random N-S wire of a few meters down the hall from the shack, but that is to be improved. An inauspicious début is caused by atrocious SW propagation conditions currently, combined with high summer storm noise levels, which no receiver can overcome. When DXing bedside, which is normally around midnight and after sunrise, it's still the FRG-7 (or the DX-398 for MW). I may not always specify which receiver is in use. Many, many, thanks, Jim!

Receiving & Recording 18 MHz/16 bit

Hi - as just two additional FDM-S2 receivers completed my trio, I successfully tried the following:

- * connect all three receivers to my 20 m quadloop via two Heros splitters
- * connect the three SDRs via several USB 3.0 sockets on a quite powerful desktop
- * open three different instances of SDR Console with 6,1 MHz each (= 15 MHz of alias-free range)
- * let it roll

Reception and decoding on all three receivers was very smooth, as recording of it had been. All three recordings then had been processed by SDR Data File Analyser: There was no interruption visible, and also "play" of each file was very smooth.

As this is just a "proof of concept", some more information of "how to" and about what to do with this incredible wide range will follow. Most obviously, you will receive, record, play and analyze e.g. all broadcast bands from 90 m to 16 m in a row, and at high quality.

It's like a wonder that you now may record and play 15 MHz of HF at a price, I had payed back in the mid-70's for a Drake SPR-4 ...

Windows 10

Hello, For those of you using Perseus... I have updated one of my computers to Windows 10 today. I did not expect any problem with Perseus v 4.1a, and I can now confirm that it works fine.

The Perseus program shows up as always after updating the operating system, but the USB-driver has to be reinstalled. Same procedure as with Windows 8/8.1 here. The Microtelecom drivers are unsigned and Microsoft sees this as a security problem. Before installing you have to disable driver signature enforcement (Google for instructions on how to do this).

Windows 10 Update issue

Good morning Windows lovers, the inflexible way that Microsoft pushes Windows 10 updates onto the users can surely be a problem for people with remote listening stations. I myself will wait a good while with upgrading my remote unit from the reliable Windows 7 to Windows 10.

Have found that Windows 10 has a function (Advanced under the WiFi tab on Settings) that prohibits updates to be downloaded on connections with "data princes". This is to ensure cost control for users with mobile broadband. Seems that applying this setting stops the updates coming.

Have by now installed Windows 10 Home on two computers. Updating a HP desktop Win 7 PC went unbelievably smooth. To update my newer Windows 8.1 Lenovo laptop was a nightmare with several bluescreens and a rollback to Win 8.1 before reaching the goal.

Also tried some more SDR related software in this new environment. SDR-Console 1.5 (build 1425) works as before. So does the Elad FDM-SW2 console 1.100 (beta).

A good, reasonably priced, CUDA card

If anyone is wanting to upgrade their graphics card, it is quite tricky knowing what to buy. With cards ranging from about £15, to well over £400 there are a real mountain of options. After much research, I eventually found a very reasonably priced (50 GBP) **Gigabyte NVidia GT730** (that is available through Amazon, EBay, etc). This card 2GB of graphics RAM, has CUDA capability and, importantly, uses fast DDR5 RAM instead of the more usual, and much slower, DDR3 RAM that is found on graphics cards around this price point, and up to £100. I am very pleased with the performance of the card (it has a cooling fan but is nearly silent in operation). For 50 pounds it is a no brainer, if you are looking to upgrade.

Works beautifully with SDR Console - I run 2, sometimes 3 instances of SDR console at a time, with 3 VFO's running on each, so that probably gets pretty graphics intensive. Thought I would take the opportunity to upgrade and utilise the CUDA technology that Simon has been working on. Only thing is I had to update my MB BIOS so that it recognised the card.

It knocks the 1GB ATI Radeon 6750, that was in the system previously, into a cocked hat - and the drivers are reputed to be more stable than ATI's (or, rather AMD as they now are).

I have no affiliation to any of these brands, it's just my own user experience.
