Minnesord över Björn Fransson



John Ekwall. Björn Fransson BF "Beff" var en av mina första bekantskaper inom DX. Jag träffade honom i Åstorp 1967-1968 i samband med ett DX-läger på Klåverödsåsen. Därefter blev det mer sporadiska kontakter i Hofors och vid DX-Parlament.

Beff var en synnerligen produktiv man, framförallt genom sin spalt "Mest för novisen" i Eter-Aktuellt som han författade under åtskilliga år. I samband med studier i Stockholm passade jag på att hälsa på familjen i Fransson i Visby några gånger i början av 70-talet. Det blev ytterligare ett par visiter till Gotland på 90-talet.

Björn var en passionerad lyssnare och idag rapportskrivare, som visar sig i en imponerande samling av verifikationer. Rätt tidigt blev det Afrika som lockade honom men även hemliga "clandestine" stationer som han lade ner mycket tid på. Första stationen inom det området var brevet från Radio Swan från. På 80-talet blev det lyssning av hobby-pirater som poppade upp – först på KV men senare på MV. Ett bra radioläge medförde fina hörigheter både på MV och KV. Björn och broder Ove sporrade varandra under sin uppväxt i Klintehamn, så det blev en hel del NA-QSL i samlingen. Eftersom Beff var så aktiv på banden blev han även medlem i SWB och bidrog flitigt.

I samband med en återförening av Krök på Karön för några år sedan, fick Björn träffa sin hockey-bockey kompis Nils Olsson (Brasilien) från tiden i Åstorp. Det var mycket nostalgi och gamla gubbar på den träffen i min sommarstuga på Karön.

Bara för några veckor sedan fick jag beskedet att Björn blev att allt sämre av sin sjukdom, så jag åkte över till Gotland och fick umgås med honom under några dagar.

Nu är Björn borta och lämnar efter sig en massa trevliga minnen hos många men framförallt ett stort tomrum.

Christer Brunström. Vi är säkert många som, liksom jag, upptäckte radiohobbyn på 1960-talet. Alltsedan dess har namnet Björn Fransson och signaturen Beff beledsagat oss. Få män har haft lika stor betydelse för DX-hobbyn i Sverige som just Björn. Han har på väldigt många sätt varit verksam inom den organiserade DX-hobbyn i vårt land; först i DX-Alliansen och sedan i Sveriges DX-Förbund. Men organisatörerna och de oförtrutna arbetarna röner sällan någon större uppmärksamhet. Hemma på Gotland var han drivande i Murgrönan, den lokala DX-klubben.

Om föreningsarbetet skedda i det fördolda var Beffs skrivelser desto mer synliga. Vi kommer säkert alla ihåg hans långa serie texter som behandlade radio i Afrika för att inte tala om alla de välinformerade krönikor han skrev om politisk propagandaradio av olika slag. På senare tid producerade han många texter med tillbakablickar på ett långt liv där radiohobbyn spelade en stor roll.

När sjukdomen hindrade Beff från att skriva i DX-Aktuellt förlorade tidningen en av sina mest uppskattade medarbetare.

Själv träffade jag Beff på många ARC-konvent och DX-Parlament. Vi var båda intresserade av frimärken med radio som motiv. Inom detta område hade Björn en omfattande samling som han behöll ända till slutet.

Men Beff hade många andra strängar på sin lyra. Han sysslade med sport. Jag vill minnas att det var orientering. Ibland kom det kort eller brev från honom och inte sällan på

miljövänligt papper. Beff var nämligen mycket engagerad i miljöpolitik.

Vi i SWB har nu förlorat en medlem och vän som kanske inte var speciellt aktiv på banden under senare tid men som dessförinnan varit på ständig jakt efter nya hörigheter. Han var på många sätt en typisk stations- och landjägare och hans signatur figurerade ofta här i SWB.

Jag träffade Björn för sista gången på DX-Parlamentet i Stockholm i våras. Det är svårt att föreställa sig att han nu, bara några månader senare, är borta.

Antenna Fire Puts SAQ Alexanderson Alternator Station Off the Air

(Further to an earlier report). ARRL, October 18, 2016

An early October fire in the SAQ Alexanderson alternator long-wave antenna is under investigation by the Grimeton World Heritage Foundation, which owns and manages the station in Grimeton, Sweden. The fire, attributed to arcing, was quickly extinguished, and no injuries occurred. The Foundation said that determining the extent of damage and completing repairs could take a while.

"There is a risk that the incident will affect the planned transmissions with the long-wave transmitter SAQ for some time to come," a Foundation announcement said. The fire will keep SAQ off the air for a scheduled UN Day transmission on October 24. SAQ, which operates on 17.2 kHz, also typically schedules transmissions on Christmas Eve and other occasions.

Dating from the 1900s, the Alexanderson alternator — essentially an ac generator run at extremely high speed — can put out 200 kW but typically is operated at less than one-half that power level. Once providing reliable transatlantic communication, it is now a museum piece and only put on the air on special occasions. It was built in the 1920s.

St. Helena operation postponed again!

Southgate, October 18, 2016

Bill, G0VDE, reports that the opening of St. Helena airport still has 'continuing serious problems' and 'it is still not possible to land sensible sized aircraft like 737 there'.

He states, "The planned flights (in May/June and October by Atlantic Star) have been cancelled. The Comair flights from South Africa have likewise not started. All in all, it is a total mess and the UK government is being accused of building a £250 Million white elephant of an unusable airfield, all due to the strong winds and wind shear!"

I have had to cancel, re-book and cancel my accommodation - if you read the ZD7 'newsletters' (the St. Helena Sentinel and the St Helena Independent) you will see it has been a very sorry story - hotels were encouraged to prepare extra rooms for the coming 'tourist boom' and one has even reportedly gone out of business, because they spent a lot to prepare and have now got no means of recovering their losses!"

Bill states, "So I am afraid I am not going this October either (having had to cancel my May/June trip). I am keeping somewhat up-to-date about the events on my website <sthele nadx.com> - but there is no planned date for the full airport opening so I don't have any certain future date.

"You may know the boat (the RMS St. Helena) was due to retire at the end of July, but it has been kept in operation for about another year as it is obviously the only way of accessing the island. I am looking at the possibility of traveling by the boat, but the problem there is two fold - the cost is at least double the planned cost of flying, and I would have to travel for two weeks and only be able to stay for one week..."

It is just possible I will take this option, but I am still waiting as I could theoretically fly at quite short notice, should proper flights begin.

We therefore have sorry situation and a continuing delay - I will try to keep everyone posted. Maybe the only silver lining is that ZD7 will get rarer and any future visit would be popular!" <http://www.southgatearc.org/>
