**BRAZIL.** Reporting about the closure of RTM, August 9 at 0150, I said ``But can't hear any carrier around 5940v with heavy splash from 5935 WWCR``. However, I was misremembering its 50mb frequency – 5965 for RTM, not 5940- Voz Missionária. I don't think 5965 has been reported for some time, certainly not by me. However, via swingpost, a lengthy translation of a discussion earlier in the day about quitting SW, said ``We had ended the 31 meters transmission, now we're ending the 25 meters, 49 meters also, and we are so sorry about that.`` This seems to imply that 9530 had been terminated earlier, but 5965 was being turned off the same date as 11735.

The latest report I can find of 5965 was from Claudio Galaz, Chile, this year: ``\*\* BRAZIL. 5965, R. TRANSMUNDIAL. Mayo 7. 1013-2028 UT. Hombre predica en portugués. SINPO: 35343 con señal sin siseos de otra emisora.. ¿EWTN, de 5970, fuera del aire?`` He probably meant until 1028 UT. Maybe they did not run it in the evenings when I am listening? (Glenn Hauser, OK, DX LISTENING DIGEST)

PNG's NBC Western is to reinstate short wave services on Daru Island.

The station has been facing neglect for two years, deteriorating staff housing, to rundown studio facilities, to non-operation of FM services in the Province.

As there is no standby generator the station is dependent on the town power supply and recently NBC Western was off air as the town supply was cut for a number of days.

The installation of a short-wave service is seen as a quick fix so that the station can continue to keep the local population informed of local and national news and issues (via Artie Bigley, DXLD)

**PAPUA NEW GUINEA.** In light of the item in WOR iog, about the possible reactivation of NBC Western, I therefore checked on Sept 2, at 1006, all of the 90 meter band, as well as 3905, with the result that NBC Madang today was the only active PNG station. The often heard NBC Bougainville (3325) was silent today. My last reception of NBC Western, was on 3305 kHz., back in March, 2012 and heard with a positive ID for "N B C Western."

NBC Western is named for the "Western Province" in southwestern PNG. Have to wonder what ever happened to the Radio Fly SW transmitters (3915 & 5960 kHz.), at Kiunga, in the North Fly district, that were owned and operated by the Ok Tedi Mining Ltd.? It was in Aug 2012, that I last heard Radio Fly on 3915. They have been silent for many years now. Would think NBC would look into the possibility of buying the transmitters if they were still operational? Roseanne ("Rosie") Kulupi (former Radio Fly radio technician and announcer) left the station many years ago and I have lost track of what the current situation is with the Radio Fly transmitters. Nice picture of Rosie up on Mt. Robinson, with some of the communications techs. In the background are some of Ok Tedi's facilities to process the mine's gold and copper - <https://app.box.com/s/uhm382tbyzy84fhvss7q> .

**USA. 5950 // much stronger 9395,** Aug 13 at 0109, VOA news is starting at flexible time via WRMI Oldies stream, until 0113 (instead of Argentina To The World on weekdays). Includes two AP voice reports and only one from a VOA correspondent. Mike Cooper, Atlanta, August 6, opined in DXLD 18-32 and quoted on WOR 1942:

``VOA NEWS IS SECOND-HAND --- Voice of America seems to have largely abdicated responsibility for original reporting in its hourly newscasts, though there is now a new nondescript news sounder.

(Whoopee!) The lead story on the 1600 newscast today was verbatim news copy from Reuters, followed by audio from a Reuters television correspondent. After this report, there were three different Associated Press audio reports on different topics. The amount of time devoted to these Reuters and AP audio reports far outweighed the minimal amount of news copy read by the news anchor.

It's hard to see how heavy reliance on audio reports from third-party news services (which have multiple worldwide news outlets as their clients) satisfies the requirement in VOA's charter that "VOA will serve as a consistently reliable and authoritative source of news." By regurgitating news reports airing on many other TV and radio outlets, VOA is no longer a "source of news." The last vestiges of original VOA reporting can be found in the half-hour news programs to Africa and Asia and in "International Edition," but even these programs contain their share of useless fluff.

How can VOA justify itself as distinguishable from commercial outlets if it is going to use the same material they air?``
