

Mysterious radio signals from deep space detected

BBC News report astronomers have revealed details of mysterious signals emanating from a distant galaxy, picked up by a

telescope in Canada.

The precise nature and origin of the blasts of radio waves is unknown. Among the 13 fast radio bursts, known as FRBs, was a very unusual repeating signal, coming from the same source about 1.5 billion light years away.

Such an event has only been reported once before, by a different telescope. "Knowing that there is another suggests that there could be more out there," said Ingrid Stairs, an astrophysicist from the University of British Columbia (UBC).

"And with more repeaters and more sources available for study, we may be able to understand these cosmic puzzles – where they're from and what causes them."

The CHIME observatory, located in British Columbia's Okanagan Valley, consists of four 100-metre-long, semi-cylindrical antennas, which scan the entire northern sky each day.

The telescope only got up and running last year, detecting 13 of the radio bursts almost immediately, including the repeater.

According to the station's schedule, 1745 is the nominal schedule, assuming availability of power which has been an issue in Bukavu. Bukavu is currently undergoing a "gold rush" as gold was discovered in the area recently and this has greatly inflated pricing in the region. This in turn impacted Radio Kahuzi's move to their new site and getting the station back on the air in 2018. I spoke with Barbara Smith yesterday and the improved signal strength has been due to a new Inverted V SW antenna that was installed at the new transmitter/studio site in Bukavu. The antenna installation was completed in July 2018 with assistance from an engineer from SonSet Solutions in Elkhart IN (SonSet Solutions was formerly HCJB Engineering but became independent when HCJB became Reach Beyond). Ultra-Rare DX: Logging Radio Kahuzi in the DRC

In these days of declining activity on the shortwave bands, we don't often enjoy the experience of hearing what we might still call "rare" stations. The new year brought an exception.

On January 1st, 2019 I was tuning around the 48 meter

band, which is largely populated by European pirate stations, utilities, and weather stations, when I heard a station on 6,210.20 khz. It was very distinct in that it sounded like an African station — music, with a male DJ/MC and religious songs.

What immediately came to mind was the religious station calling itself Radio Kahuzi, which is in Bukavu, Democratic Republic of Congo.

Vermutlich gibt es noch aus dem Kalten Krieg nur noch einen aktiven ELF-Sender, der extrem niedrige Frequenz nutzt, naemlich ZEVS der russischen Marine auf der Kola-Halbinsel bei Murmansk, der mit 82 Hertz arbeitet und

elektromagnetische Signale mit einer Wellenlaenge von 3700 km sendet. Damit laesst sich mit U-Booten bis zu einer Tiefe von 50 Metern kommunizie-

ren, wenn auch mit einer sehr geringen Bandbreite und nur einseitig vom ELF-Sender zum U-Boot. Gesendet wird mit einem Bodendipol als Antenne, der aus zwei parallelen Antennen mit jeweils einer Laenge von 60 km besteht.

Only Russia and India still have such transmitters for submarine communication, the US Navy is said to have closed its transmitter Sanguine 2004.

Presumably, there is only one active ELF transmitter from the Cold War that uses extremely low frequency, namely ZEVS of the Russian Navy on the Kola Peninsula near Murmansk, which operates at 82 hertz and transmits electromagnetic signals with a wavelength of 3700 km, This allows you to communicate with submarines to a depth of 50 meters, albeit with a very low bandwidth and only one-sided from the ELF transmitter to the submarine. It is sent with a ground dipole antenna, which consists of two \\ antennas, each with a length of 60 km.


