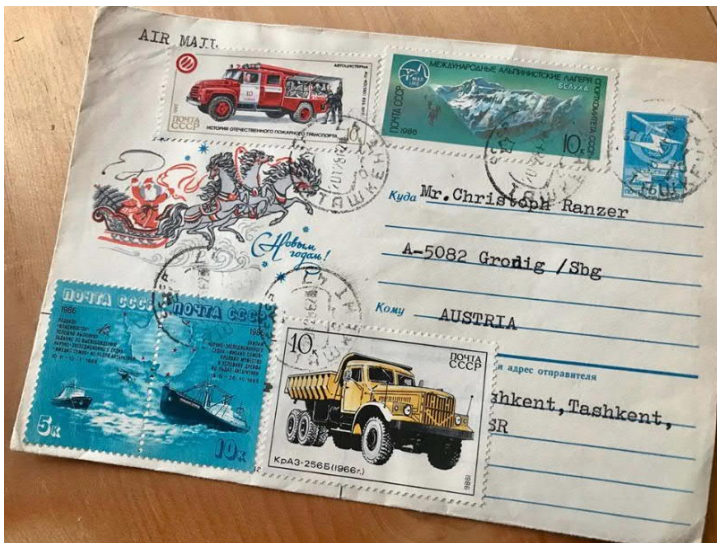

Of those 32, five are still members of DXplorer: Gerry Dexter and Dan Ferguson (both of whom joined NU with issue No. 2), Chris Lobdell (issue No. 12), Dan Henderson (issue No. 19), yours truly (issue No. 33), and Wendel Craighead (issue No. 35).

The shortwave broadcast DX world has changed massively during the last 50 years, of course, but for many of us who "grew up" in it, there are a lot of great memories. So, at least vicariously -- Happy Birthday!

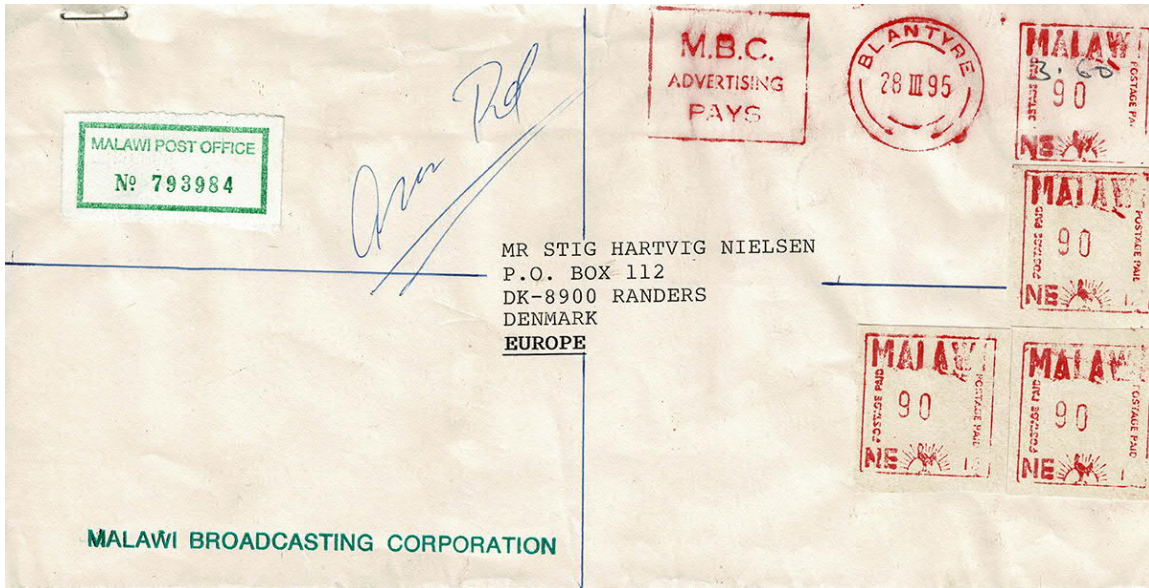

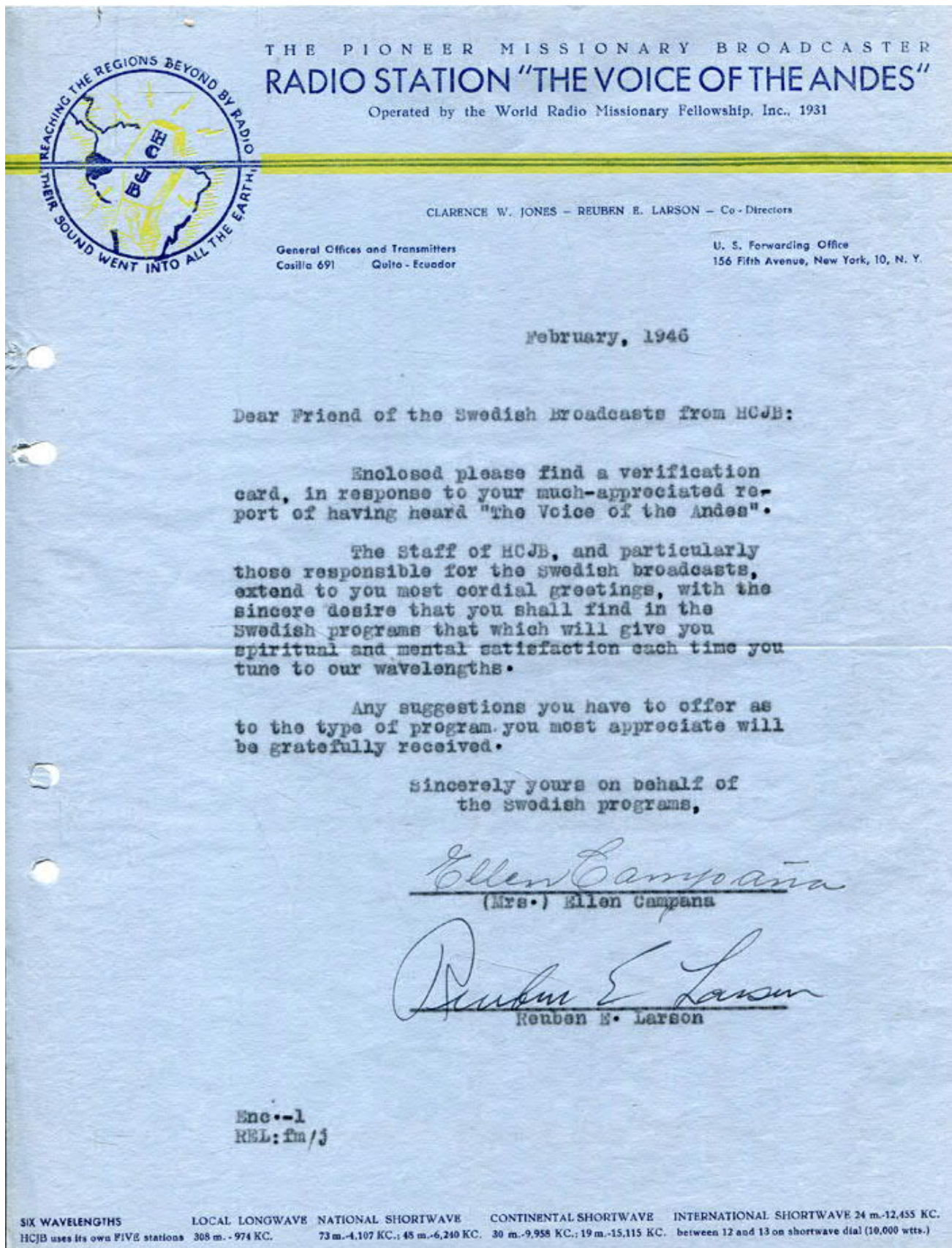
