OMAN - Taking a break from a monitoring project on the short wave frequencies of Saudi Arabia, I stopped at the reactivated frequency of Radio Sultanate of Oman, 15140 kHz. The English hour taken from Oman FM - the nation's station - 90.4 FM was heard at its usual time with its usual mix of Western music. For a Westerner, it is always interesting to suddenly hear birds chirping and reminding listeners to not forget the Muslim sunset prayer. And a little later Western music pops in again with Western loudness. Another usual feature was sports talk, this time on snooker. The most remarkable feature was a statement of the Indian ambassador (probably in Malayalam, certainly not Hindi) broadcast at 1425 and 1456 h encouraging/advising Indian expatriates in these times of the Corona crisis and giving contact numbers (,,helpline"). The repeated statement was not fully broadcast, because at 1458 h, the frequency was returned to the Arabic service of Radio Sultanate of Oman.

Shortwave Bulletin - membership request

Good day Thomas,

Please allow me to first introduce myself. My name is Antonio (but everybody calls me Antonello) Napolitano and I live in Taranto, a city of Southeast Italy, East Southeast of Naples, on the Gulf of Taranto, an arm of the Ionian Sea.

Taranto is situated in the region of Puglia, also known as Apulia, which occupies the extreme South-eastern tip of the country (The heel of Italy's boot!). It is the third-largest continental city of Southern Italy after Naples and Bari: according to 2011 population census, it has a population of 200,154. The once-mighty Greek-Spartan colony of Taras is, today, Italy's second biggest naval base after La Spezia, a major commercial port and, unfortunately also the home to the "ArcelorMittal" steel plant (Europe's biggest in terms of output capacity, employs at least 14,000 people) which has long been suspected of being a major health risk and the cause of serious environmental degradation, belching a mix of minerals, metals and carcinogenic dioxins into the air, day and night.

I am 55 years old and for many years (since 1979) I have enjoyed the hobby commonly referred to as **DXing**, that is listening to distant radio stations on both shortwave and medium wave, sending them reception reports and hoping to get some kind of confirmation in return (I have more than 100 countries verified). Of course listening over the internet would be possible at this age as well, but I really prefer to try to do it the harder way. To be honest due to the heavy noise today I am not able to repeat some DX catches as in the past: under the 9 MHz band it's really hard to receive a faint signal. I am going to makea dream of mine reality: in the next month I 'll buy an house outside the city not so fra from the sea and I am sure the electric noise would not be so strong as in my current home location

I work for a shipping agency but I am also a journalist and radio speaker. I like travelling and for this reason I visited a fairly good number of countries including Albania, Andorra, Gibraltar, Cuba, Indonesia, Egypt, Mozambique, Swaziland, South Africa, and Tunisia. When possible I visit some radio stations and then write a report (<u>https://dxfanzine.word-press.com/2015/09/10/dx-fanzine-nr-25-september-2015/</u> In this edition of DX fanzine you can find my article in English about Radio Timisoara in Romania)

I am a free-lance journalist, who has also worked for a number of local radio stations (among them also Radio West, now defunct, which from 28 June 1986 to 12 July 1986 made some tests on a short wave frequency of 11505 kHz with reception reports received from France, Austria, Holland, former Czechoslovakia and of course Italy) and blogger specialized in media and communication.

It is available on the web at <u>www.dxfanzine.com</u> and is intended to allow the quick release of reception notes of shortwave broadcasts from any continent. At the end of each month its contents are turned into a PDF bulletin which is being sent out free of charge to a little more than 400 shortwave enthusiasts around the world. DX fanzine is a mix of DX catch and easy to listen stations. There are only 5/6 contributors and quality is subject to their ability to catch DX stations.

DX Fanzine keeps an old style way of making a shortwave bulletin: DX logs in frequency order (not assembled with the usual past and copy method) and QSL notes, which in my opinion are the items that most find the attention of shortwave listeners. With a few exceptions, I desist from taking DX news from other sources as I notice that the same information is available on dozens of Facebook groups, websites, e-mail lists and so on, and I don't want to make a bulletin which is a "relay" of others. I try to include unedited news and if this are not available patience! Logs and QSL notes are enough.

I own a number of shortwave receivers and sdrs: among them the ICOM ICR 70, Kenwood R-1000, Sony ICF 2100, Xhaday 808, Perseus and Elad FD SM 1 just to mention a few. But the receiver I mostly use is still the older ICOM IC R 70,

Well, sorry if you find that my introduction was too long. Just I forgot to mention that I wish to become a member of SWB's team. Attched please find the latest edition of DX Fanzine.






An oldie but a goodie. Station JCKW of the Forces Broadcasting Service in Cairo verified the reception report from Jan-Erik Räf JER by this card in 1945.



La Voix de la Revolution – Radiodiffusion Nationale in Guinea was easy to hear but hard to get verified. Tore Larsson succeeded to get them in 1966. The stamps show Russian cosmonaut Pavel Belyayev who was the commander of the spacecraft Voskhod 3KD in 1965. His colleague on board, Alexei Leonov, became the first person ever to leave the spacecraft in a specialized spacesuit to conduct a 12-minute spacewalk.



Another one from Tore's collection: the Nihon Short-wave Broadcasting Station in Tokyo.



There used to be a number of small Turkish shortwave stations aside from the state radio. Even the Turkish Police was operating their own SW station. QSL from Lars-Olof Hansson LOH.
