## REPORT FROM PERU part XXI (Oct 23-Dec 12)

- 3260 La Voz de Oxapampa, Pasco, Peru is back here with 30 over 9 signal Nov 11.
- 3593.6 UNID ,... , Bolivia?? First heard with Argentine folkloric music (milongas), by Jose Larralde. So presumably a Bolivian. Totally distorted signal, but understandable in AM. Heard Nov 28 0100-0115 abrupt cd.
- 4182 R Gran Pajatén, Celendín, Peru now varying here 4125-4182, missing from its earlier 4096. Now closer to its announced 4200 KHz. Heard the same canned ID as 18 months ago.. "R Gran Pajatén, hermanando los departamentos de La Libertad, Amazonas, San Martín y Cajamarca". Slogan "Pajatén, tu mejor compañía". Heard Oct 31-12 Dec)
- 4734 R San Juan de Caraz, Caraz, Ancash, Peru now here x4733, cd 0200
- 4935.4 R Municipal de Abancay is stable here, not on 4998 as WRTH says!!
- 5120.4 R Mundo, Cuzco, Cuzco, Peru is back at the air after 2 1/2 month inactivity. Good signal as usual, giving the address again as Monjaspata No 701.
- 5190.7 R Nuevo Continente, Cajamarca, Peru is back at the air Nov 13. Previously only heard Oct 10 & 11. As usual, very good signal.
- 5281.1 R San José, ... , Cajamarca, Peru is a MW-harmonic from 1320.2 (last SWI)
- 5623.6-5620.3-5618.4 UNID Peruvian stn heard here, wandering downwards, just above Ilucan, with distorted and low strength signal. Lots of talk, some music. Heard from about 2140 until 2230.
- 5810.8 R Acunta, Chota, Cajamarca, Peru on new frequency. Amazing signal, perfect modulation Nov 11. Seems of course a new transmitter, not only because for the first time in 18 months they leave 5800 vicinity, but also because of its new power, exactly at the same level of its neighbour R San Juan de Chota (1 kW). However the following day heard on 5789.9
- 6284.9 RDifusora Acreana is the one here. Mixing product of 4884.9+1440
- 6363.5 R Huallaga, Saposoa, San Martín, Peru now seems to have begun regular commercial operations because heard with lots of commercials for Saposoa stores, and heard regularly, daily. Announcer however the same as Estación C - R Moderna. Announcing studios in front of "Plaza de Armas" in Saposoa.
- 9595.1 R Monte Carlo, Montevideo, Uruguay heard here Nov 25 with news of the first democratic election in Uruguay for more than 13 years. Heard 1900, from 2130 QRM from NSB via longpath.

(I'm longing for the spring, and all the nice Peruvian stns again! /ed)

COLOMBIA Some news about the UNID stn on 5936.7 heard by your editor & others:

5936 CARACOL Carreno, new station! Heard 2220-2359cd Nov 30. Strong signal with good audio. Lots of HJ pops, llanera music, some very rustic ballads (sounding like quenas). Lots of ads for stores and events in Puerto Carreno and also for the Venezuelan frontier town of Puerto Ayacucho. Sign off without ID, but mentions Puerto Carreno, Vichada, frontera oriente colombiana, and a truly stirring operatic rendition of the Colombian himno nacional, says Reinstein and others.

INDONESIAN REPORT by RWP on next page!

INDONESIA - 3425, RPD2 Indragiri Hilir, Tembilahan, Propinsi Riau, So. Sumatera. Here's one long thought to have existed, but never before "DXed" prior my log on 5 Jan at 0110-0215. Hrd w/big, solid Sumateran sig, and excellent modulation, both amts and mournful Indo love song 0132-0202 running cultural program transcription about Sumateran indigenous cultures like the Minangkabaus. At 0203, there song "Help Me Make it Through The Night" and then OM introduces regional nxcast, "Radio Pusat Informasi Udara Indragiri, dengan warta berita daerah dan warta negeri...Tingkat Kab. Indragiri Hilir..." Many local QTHs mentioned, incl. Tembilahan and Rengat, which is ibukota of sister regency of Indragiri Hulu. Quick abbreviated ID 0210 simply as "Radio Indragiri." An enjoyable catch. (Perry)

3901v, new freq, RPD Kab. Karo, Kabinjahe, the peripatetic Pemerintah'er of N. Sumatera makes another move! Here since 30 Dec with vastly improved signal which will likely make it overseas. Vy nice clarity, steady signal, though drifts in range 3901-3897. Before this latest NF, I settled for a few weeks on 4350-55v range with reasonable power but horrendous mod. Still ancing "72 meter band", and probably always will as that's been the "official" freq since that 1974 listing DF uncovered! Sig too good on 3900v to not be intentional. Often hrd w/lagupops like local version of "Flahdance", Jak nx rlys faithfully picked up. ID 0104 on 5 Jan as "Inilah Radio Pemerintah Daerah Kab. Karo di udara gelombangnya 72 meter band." Enjoyable ads include those for kecap (soya sauce) "Miki Mouse", and the ubiquitous Pepsodent jingles. (Perry)

3017s, RPD2 Kampar, Bangkinang, Propinsi Riau, So. Sumatera. Ditto the remarks on Tembilaha item above -- here's the whereabouts of another one we all thought probably existed. Noted 1 Jan 85 with fair but fadey sig at 0100 (9 a.m. locally), improving somewhat with time. Pm of lagu melayu, some greetings to listeners. Held to 0310 t/o. A local stn w/a sense of humour: anon joking and laughing his way through listeners' ltrs, amused in particular by one who tho't stn was more exalted than it actually is -- "no, no, bukan radio ini Radio Republik Indonesia. Belum! Ini Radio Pem-da, baik-lah!" (No, no, this station isn't RRI -- not yet! This is regional govt radio, right!) Lots of "Apa Khabars" (what's new?) to listeners in Bangkinang. Caught ID as soon as I found this one's audio: at 0102 OM "...selamat pagi pada pendengar-teman dari Radio Pemerintah Daerah Tkt II Kampar...". (Perry)

2433, RRI Banda Aceh, big sig tho bad QRM at 1240 w/nondescript Indo pops. At 1258, YL gave local ID, "Inilah Radio Rep. Indonesia Banda Aceh di gelombang 125 meter..." Don't know how typical the Sumaterans are compared to all the rest of Indonesians, and the Sumateran RPD stns in particular compared to the rest, but I've been struck that the ID-on-the-hr is a definite nonstarter of a concept! Virtually never a local ID from Sumateran RPDs before joining Jakarta for a relay . . . tho nearly always a local ID, of sorts, upon returning to the local program. Now, RRI's are probably a completely different matter -- more disciplined re ID frequency. (Perry)

3784-3794, unid Indo, non-RRI, same as stn prev hrd 3800v. This one a real mystery, and many hrs devoted to cracking this one to no avail, thus far. Best IDs have remained elusive, tho partial comprehension would indicate this is a vy interesting stn, not an RPD stn and not a Kotamadya stn, tho evidently a municipal stn of sorts. On 2 Jan at 1130-1415 hrd w/reqes show. At 1210, after Jak rly, amnt: "Kembali disini ke Radio Suara Kota ( ? ) yang...gelombang tinggal 75,3 meterband frekwensi 3984,06 KHz..." Remote chance this is located in Pangkalanbran but not confirmed. A most frustrating stn! (Perry)

General note: DXers have been missing out on one tool for siting unid stns. While nothing works quite like an ID (hi), every added clue helps. I've been finding that the Azan Maghrib, the evening call to prayer, is a dandy way to determine approximate longitude of stn within the Indo archipelago since the darkness terminator gives you a great general idea. The DX Edge sliderule device is perfect for this. Now, this idea should of course be used with caution, but at least here in Kuala Lumpur, the time for evening call to prayer is scientifically calculated right down to the second, with a big clock appearing on TV screens at dusk, counting off the seconds! Reasonable to expect at least some degree of precision, for Allah's sake, in Indonesia! (Perry)

... IDs under the microscope: 3657s at 3905, lush rx and poor modulation; 3705v-3712, relaying Jakarta at 0330; 4 Suwaha; 3290s; 3770 at 0220; 3541 to 0332\*; and etc!
