Here follows an article about his visit to Sweden written by JOE:

JCC VISITS SWEDEN

Tuesday 17th of September was the big day when Juan Carlos Codina came to Sweden. After some phone-calls to Switzerland, I persuaded Juan to make a trip to Sweden and be my guest for a couple of days.

Arriving by train from Copenhagen (after a over-nite stay at Finn Krone), Hermod Pedersen I met the "the legendary" Juan Carlos Codina at the railway station in Elsinore. We couldn't miss him - he was "loaded" with luggage including the NRD515 receiver and a very good temper.

It's always nice meeting the person behind the signature, and this time even nicer, as JCC has been the DX-focus during the last years. His DX-reports from Imfa, Peru has been of highest class and interest throughout the DX-world.

After an hour of shopping, we catch the ferry to Helsingborg and some hours of interesting chat. As HeP is the AA-editor of Eter-Aktuellt, Juan Carlos had to answer a lot of questions (see coming article in Eter-Aktuellt). Well, time was running and JCC and I had to say good-bye to HeP as we had a 200 kms drive ahead us.

Unfortunately, we had no luck on the bands the first nite on Karön - a small island 5 kms south of Ronneby. We tried on "the golden hour" (i.e between 2300 and 2400 hours UTC), but JCC was rather exhausted, so he had a good nights sleep.

On Wednesday HeP arranged a day off from work and came running, and some hours later, Kenneth Olofsson arrived with the afternoon-meal - various fish-dishes in typical Swedish way. After JCC's stay in Japan some yeasr ago, he was familiar with raw fish. It didn't took long before the first "skål" was heard. Now the real chat started. We had discussions about politics, fishing (comparison with Argentina and Sweden), work, radio and so on. After 3 hours we were hungry, so the barbecue took place. HeP had purchased a very tasteful Rioja Gran Reserva, so this late dinner was a superb ending of this beautiful day.

Thursday came and the program-schedule said "visit to Växjö and Hans Gustavsson, Hasse Mattisson and Tomas Svcensson". Just 15 kms south of Växjö, we stopped and had a glimpse at the beverage-farm at Krokvik, were HGV/HM/TS has erected several 600-1200 metres long antennas. Over a cup of coffee we had a nice chat. Juan Carlos told about his experiences with NRD515 as HGV also have one. When HM was in Switzerland in August, he stayed at a hotel in Muri, unaware of that JCC often visits this particular hotel for lunch! Well, 2 hours flew away, and we started a night-trip to Norrköping in rainy weather..

Friday evening was entirely devoted to Satellite-TV at Stefan Bursell. Juan Carlos was deeply impressed to SB's 4 m parabolic antenna. Stefan guided JCC through all available TV-channels, including ATC (this was the highlight during JCC's visit. SB has succeded to have colour from Argentina and JCC enjoyed 100% this this visit.

It was 1 o'clock in the night, when we had to leave the pictures from his dear Argentina. Juan Carlos was hungry, so I had to stop stop at a hamburger bar. JCC ordered 2 big hamburgers, after 10 minutes he had enough.

Saturday morning - the start for 300 kms drive to Borlänge and the active members of Stora Tuna DX-klubb. Arriving on schedule, Juan Carlos was the focus for questioning. About the radio-situation in Peru, he told us that the amount of new stations already was present when he arrived in Lima 3 years ago. So there was no particular boom in broadcasting during his stay. Lars Simm presented a recording of a new unidentified Peruvian on 3280. After listening, JCC belived the name was Estación "Idealn" in Ayacucho.

Just outside Borlänge, the boys in STDXK have their listening, on a top of a hill with excellent view around. We tried to listen for some Indonesian stations, but conditions were poor.

On Saturday evening - le grand finale - dinner in Grängesberg together with Jan Tunér. On behalf of Grängesberg Radioklubb we showed JCC our appreciation for his excellent monitoring for the 1984 Nordic Open DX-Championship. Some interesting hours of discussions before we had to go to sleep.

Sunday morning 5.30 breakfast and then goodbye to JT. 230 kms later a heartly goodbye and Juan Carlos enter the train for Switzerland. 24 hours later JCC back home in Muri, full of memories from his trip to Sweden.
