Proposed freq changes for provincial stns: Morobe 3215 x3220, Madang 3255 x3260, Central 3285 x3290, Simbu 3355 x2376, Milne Bay 3365 x3360, Enga will eventually move to 3 MHz, but freq not yet assigned, this acc to Gordon Darling
